-Masters "49er Gold Rush": High equity, single elimination, all matches CLOCKED, 3 rounds on Friday. Each round is 11pts. Early start at 2pm, Late start at 6:30pm on Friday.

-Limited Jackpot: High equity, open to players not of high championship level, single elimination. 3 rounds on Friday. Each round is 7pts. Early start at 2pm, Late start at 7pm on Friday.

-Open - Swiss: Open to all players, Swiss pairings will continue until there is only one player with fewer than 3 losses. All matches CLOCKED (see Game Clocks).

-Advanced - Swiss: Our middle division, Swiss pairings will continue until there is only one player with fewer than 3 losses. No entrant will be allowed to play below his/her level.

-Novice: Open to players with minimal skill level & tournament experience, plus approval of our eligibility committee. Register or call for approval.

-Doubles: Open to all players, brackets of 8 teams. All matches CLOCKED.

-Older and Wiser versus Young Guns: 2 brackets; born before 10/23/1952 (Old) and on or after (Young), continuous entry, 7-pt matches. Finals will be between winners of both brackets. **\$200 added money.**

-Blitzes: Brackets of 4, winner gets \$60 and secures a "playoff" spot for Monday.

-Ted Chee Bounty 2-point Mini Match: Continuous entry; \$10 bounty for everyone beating Ted Chee. **\$200 added money.**



GAME CLOCKS: All matches will be CLOCKED in the Open & Masters (12sec/2min) & Doubles (18sec/2.5min). At the Tournament Director's discretion, clocks may be required in other matches.

Notes: - Non-Smoking Tournament -DEPOSIT amounts or full payments for Masters, Limited Jackpot and Main divisions must be postmarked by Aug 10th, 2017. The remainder is due at final registration, FRIDAY NIGHT, in Cash only (fully refundable up to the time of the draws).

Tournament Format

Players will be eliminated when they get their fourth loss.

Byes will be treated as wins.

Swiss pairings will continue until there is only one player with fewer than 3 losses.

Players with 3 losses are still eligible to cash, but can no longer win the tournament.

In the Advanced division, all players with three or fewer losses at the end of round 9 will cash.

In the Championship division, all players with three or fewer losses at the end of round 10 will cash.

Players eliminated in the same round will be awarded the same payout position, with ties combined and split equally.

Pairing Rules

No player can receive a second bye until all remaining players have had at least one bye. Byes are awarded to a player with the worst possible record.

Two players will not play each other in consecutive rounds unless they are the last two players with fewer than three losses.

Players will be paired against players with as similar a record as possible.

Players will be paired against players they have not played in previous rounds.

If a player has played a previous round against an opponent with a better record, they will not be paired against a player with a better record again. If a player has played a previous round against an opponent with a worse record, they will not be paired against a player with a worse record again.

Note that as the number of remaining players decreases, the pairing rules become harder to enforce and we will relax them from the bottom up.

Any match that is holding up the tournament flow is likely to have a clock inserted. Director's decision is final.

The Silicon Valley Open is a BMAB-Partnered tournament. All reasonable accommodations will be made to allow BMAB applicants to set up recording equipment, and the Tournament Director will certify to BMAB that all matches were played and submitted in accordance with BMAB requirements. If you wish to make a BMAB submission of matches played at the Silicon Valley Open, please notify Ken Bame or Rick Janowski 48 hours in advance of the start of the tournament.
