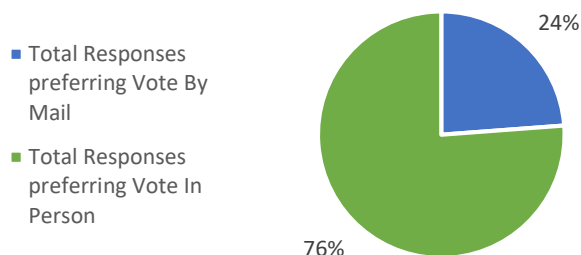

Landfill FAQ's

- Tickets are again needed for the landfill
Carload \$5; Utility Trailer \$10; Truck \$15
- Additional \$5 per item charge for appliances and furniture
- No hazardous materials accepted
- Grass, leaves and branches are free
- Shingle disposal fee = \$5.60 per approx. bundle
