SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

DUE DATE: October 7, 2022

The Board of Directors of the Volusia County Fair Association will award up to \$12,000 in college scholarships to qualifying graduating high school seniors who best exemplify their support of the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show. Up to twelve (12) scholarships may be awarded to students who meet exceptional qualifications. These twelve (12) scholarships are inclusive and include the Cultural Arts Scholarship, the George Wilkins Scholarship, the Elvin B. Daugharty Scholarship, the Volusia Stock Show Syndicate Scholarship, Bob Gast Scholarship, F. Eugene Dulac Scholarship and the Volusia County Fair Scholarships. The applicant's personal initiative in extra-curricular activities and their own personal attributes that will ensure their success in the pursuit of higher education will be taken into consideration. A scholarship is to encourage young people to pursue a college education or an educational experience following high school graduation. Enrollment in a technical college or program of study may also be applicable. Scholarship applicants must be or have been participants in the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show to qualify. Scholarship applications must be mailed or delivered to the Fair office on or before the due date. An incomplete application will not be considered to receive scholarship funds.

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior from an accredited high school (home school graduates from an accredited high school program are also eligible) in Volusia County and be a resident of Volusia County.
 2. Each applicant must submit documentation for PSAT, SAT, or ACT test requirements for high school graduation and include an official SAT and ACT test score report. In lieu of passing the aforesaid exams, an applicant may be conditionally approved upon acceptance and enrollment to a trade, vocational and technical "hands on" program at an accredited school, college or university.
 3. Each applicants must hold a 3.0 high school grade point average (based on a 4.0 system).
 4. The applicant must be a member of FFA, 4H or may be an independent exhibitor at the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show. Please specify which organization you belong to or if you are an independent. _____
 5. The applicant must have participated as an exhibitor at the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show at least two (2) of the past four (4) years. List which departments you have participated in for at least two (2) years. _____
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6. The applicant must apply the scholarship funds for tuition or fees at a two or four year college and carry at least 12 credit hours. If the funds are applied to a trade, vocational or technical "hands on" program as described above, the program of study will be followed as such. The funds will be assigned and administered by the applicant's college or university. Upon receipt of enrollment on school letter head, by the Fair office, from the college or university, the funds will be mailed to the respective school. Should the chosen applicant drop out of the school for any

reason or not carry 12 credits hours, any unused portion of the scholarship funds will be returned to the Volusia County Fair Association.

7. The scholarship deadline for the use of the funds will be twelve (12) months from high school graduation date; an exception will be made if the applicant will be serving as an FFA State Officer. Upon proof of the applicant's appointment as an FFA State Officer, the applicant will have twenty-four (24) months from high school graduation date to apply for the scholarship funds.
8. Upon receipt of confirmation of acceptance to your college or university, the funds will be sent by the Fair office to your school account.
9. Award recognition will take place at the auction of the Volusia County Fair and Youth Show. Presentation of the award letter will take place at the livestock auction (historically after the last market lamb is sold).
- 10. Each applicant will submit an essay utilizing the MLA Format (see example provided in the Academic Paper Format) under the scholarship information link on the website.** Essay: "How this Scholarship will affect my future plans." Essay should be approximately 300 words.
