Provisional= new members of CCS for approximately one year Active= regular CCS members

Membership Requirements for Provisionals

- New members are expected to give 30 hours of volunteer time during their provisional year.
- There are four general meetings per year: (2 daytime and 2 evenings). First year members are required to attend at least 2 of these meetings.
- All active and provisional members are asked to pay dues of \$50.
- The President sends out a Weekly Update via e-mail to all members. It is important to read this update as it is the key to your active participation in CCS. Upcoming events, service project news, volunteer opportunities, and last minute changes are communicated via our newsletter.
- Typically, provisional members sell tickets at the annual Red Wagon Lunch.

Becoming Active
