

public engagement meetings with residents to discuss issues and projects throughout our City.

The Lakefront SID has finally been created and includes all 13 Lake County cities, townships, villages, and the City Euclid in Cuyahoga County. This will create a much-needed funding source for erosion control improvements to our residents. The law firm working with us is expecting a term sheet from Lake Erie Bank, and we anticipate about \$10 million in the first phase of funding. We are now reaching out to Lakefront property owners to assist them in the application process.

A long-awaited resolution to the EPA issues surrounding the Commons project Riverside located at State Route 2 and Lost Nation Road reached our office recently with the final signature by the Cleveland Federal Judge hearing the case. With his signature on the consent decree, our involvement in this case ends. We are hopeful the remaining lawsuit between the developers and the EPA will also be resolved quickly.

These settlements will allow our Economic Development team to begin marketing this site.

Our Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative project for the Vine Street Corridor study has been delayed due to the impacts associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. This TLCI grant represents a \$120,000 study of Vine Street from Lakeshore Boulevard to our historic downtown. Of critical importance to this study are the traffic counts along this corridor. The reduced traffic due to the pandemic may impact design solutions, and our funding agency has postponed obtaining this data. NOACA and the Ohio Department of Transportation are evaluating alternatives for this problem to get the project underway.

Lake County is encouraging residents to sign up for their reverse 911 system. This system allows the county Emergency Management Agency to communicate with our residents in situations such flooding, extreme weather as conditions and other emergencies. Residents can find important information about this service at www.lakecountyohio.gov/ema.

Finally, we encourage our residents to visit our website to find the latest information on our projects and initiatives to see meeting dates and agendas. A new Mobile Food Pantry will be visiting communities throughout Lake County each week to provide fresh produce to seniors in need of food.

A retrofitted Laketran Dial-a-Ride bus, re-branded as the Lake County Mobile Food Pantry with vehicle graphics donated by Avery Dennison, will visit two locations each week on Tuesdays and Thursdays to distribute 60 boxes of fresh produce to senior participants.

County will place groceries in the trunk of seniors' cars as they arrive. Volunteers are equipped with PPE to ensure all participants' safety.

Similar to Laketran's produce pick-up program organized last summer with Lake County Commissioners Senior Services, RSVP of Lake County, Council on Aging and Lifeline, the agencies worked together to secure food donations from the Greater Cleveland Food Bank and each play a role in taking reservations, sorting donations and distributing the food.



Burroughs Nature Club was founded in 1916 and named after John Burroughs (1837-1921). the famous Hudson River Valley author whose popular books inspired many a turn-of-thecentury naturalist.

The Burroughs Nature Club of Willoughby was founded by outstanding Cleveland area men (scientists, scholars, naturalists, and photographers) who shared a common love of hiking, wildlife watching, and other investigations of the natural world. They also enjoyed a good hike together in the "wilds" of Lake County. Their Burroughs Nature Club remains one of the oldest such nature clubs in the nation.

Irruptive Birds are in Audubon's Sights

Certain bird species are spending this winter in Northeast Ohio in especially high numbers. Blackbrook Audubon Society encourages everyone to connect with these rare visitors and record them, as well as resident birds, for the Great Backyard Bird Count February 12 -15.

Common Redpolls and Evening Grosbeaks have flown here from Canadian latitudes. They are part of a group known as irruptive species. Both of these finches visit feeders and are easy to spot. Participants in the GBBC are invited to count all bird species and individuals for at least 15 minutes on one or more days that weekend, regardless of age or birding skill level. Instructions, apps and bird ID tips are available at www. birdcount.org.

Blackbrook Audubon lists popular birding spots and links on the resources page of their website, blackbrookaudubon.org. Follow Blackbrook's Facebook page for current sightings. Contribute to this international count by adding the irruptive species to your list before they head back north and before the annual spring migration begins. Blackbrook wants participants to bird safely following the current Covid-19 guidelines.

Whether counters record birds at their feeder, in a park, or any other location, submitting these numbers will enhance the snapshot of bird distribution and abundance. This will help scientists answer questions on migration patterns, spread of diseases and the effects of weather and climate change. When the Cornell Lab of Ornithology and National Audubon Society launched GBBC in 1998, they created the first online citizenscience project to collect data on wild birds and display the results in near real-time. Birds Canada joined the effort in 2009. Birds observed locally can be compared to other reports in the region with maps on the project website during and after the count.

Last February, participants in almost 200 countries counted more than 6,900 species of birds on over 260,000 checklists. Make sure the birds in your favorite spot aren't overlooked! throughout Northeast Ohio, along with honest, fair prices.
