## Important Testing Information

Please make sure that your child gets plenty of rest and a good breakfast the days of their testing. Breakfast is provided free of charge in the cafeteria every morning, starting at 8:15 am.

Students need to be in their testing location by 9:10am. Any student who arrives after the testing has begun will have to be scheduled for make-ups. Please note the make-up dates on the calendar.

### **USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

The State of Florida and M-DCPS has issued procedures and policies regarding the use of electronic devices during any testing. This includes but is not limited to cellphones, smart watches, iPad, Android devices, or MP3 devices.

- "Possession of electronic devices is cause for invalidation" and due to security breaches involving the use of electronic devices that reproduces, transmits, calculates, or records is cause for invalidation.
- "Possession" is defined as "**within arm's reach**," even if the electronic device is not visible.
- For example, students should not have cell phones in their pockets, clipped to their belts, at their desks, or anywhere they can be easily accessible during testing.
