**MASS THEME**

**Theme: Discipleship.**  
 Discipleship and ministry are part and parcel of the Christian scene. All Christians are called to discipleship and service. The Lord continues his mission of service to humankind through the Church. And the Church is not just the ordained ministers! It is all of us. The First Reading of today was also used on Christmas Eve. In that context it referred to Jesus Christ, a light that dawned in the darkness. Here it introduces the theme of the Gospel, namely, the beginning of Jesus' ministry, which Matthew puts in the land of Zebulun and Naphtali, Galilean territory in Jesus' time. The very beginning of Jesus' ministry is marked by the calling of co-workers. Jesus said to the Galilean fishermen Simon and Andrew: "Come after me and I will make you fishers of men." The coworkers of our Lord must forward this message, hand on the torch of faith! We might ask: "How strong is that light of Christ shining in the darkness of the human condition?" If Christians leave it up to the ordained ministers to continue Christ's mission, then Christian impact on society is negligible. If all would be dedicated to Christian discipleship and ministry, a tremendous untapped source of energy would be activated for the benefit of "the people who walk in darkness. What about your discipleship and ministry? Could it be a project of your parish council?"

**BIBLICAL COMMENTARY**

**FIRST READING**  
**Is 8:23—9:3 [Joy and Light]**  
 The setting is a civil war between the two kingdoms into which the Jewish nation was split after the death of Solomon: Judah (south) and Israel (north). Judah had called in Assyrians to come to her help. They invaded Israel and took many captives among the tribes of Zebulun and Naphtali (735-732 B.C.). Isaiah saw all this as a punishment for sin, especially the king's lack of faith in God. As descendants of the great King David, they should be the representatives of God on earth. They failed! In his songs and poems, Isaiah dreams about an ideal king to come, a true king of peace, who will be Immanuel—God-with-us. Matthew sees Isaiah's aspirations fulfilled in Jesus Christ. (See the Gospel.) "Wait for the Lord with courage!" (Responsorial Psalm).

**SECOND READING**  
**1 Cor 1:10-13, 17 [Need for Unity]**  
 There is dissension in the congregation of Corinth. Paul points out that all members are called to be Christ's ministers and disciples. All share in the mission of Jesus, namely, to be a light to other human beings in dark-ness! But a house divided causes only misfortune and misery. Accepting one another, human as we are, priests, members of the parish council, and ordinary parishioners, we should be one in the faith and in our dedication to Christian discipleship and service.
