

Parish History

This is another in a series of quotes of parishioners who had written for the 50th Anniversary of Our Lady of Visitation Parish. This is to give current parishioners a sense of history as we approach the **70th Anniversary** of the founding of the parish on **February 15th**, **2020**.

"When we first became a parish in 1950, Mass was still celebrated in the school house chapel.But after our present property had been purchased, Father Gerrity, who was living at St. Patrick's Church in Carlisle, moved here. Would you believe when he moved in there wasn't any soap, toilet tissue, or even a water glass. Agnes Hunter brought over some sheets and I made up a cot..." Mary Woltz wrote in 1990.

In these writings, by the wise plan of God, those matters which concern Christ the Lord are confirmed, His true teaching is more and more fully stated, the saving power of the divine work of Christ is preached, the story is told of the beginnings of the Church and her marvelous growth, and her glorious fulfillment is foretold." 


