Our services are provided for seniors ages 60 and over, Monday through Friday.

Adult Day Care:

Provides relief for families caring for a loved one with dementia or Alzheimer's. This service is available Monday through Thursday from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. Lunch and transportation are provided.

Congregate Meals:

A hot lunch served at the Pickaway Senior Center at 11:30 AM on Monday, and at 12:00 noon Tuesday through Friday.

Homemakers:

Assistance with cleaning, laundry and running errands.
Clients must meet certain eligibility criteria.

Meals on Wheels:

A hot lunch delivered to your home five days a week.

National Family Caregiver Support Program:

Respite and personal care, financial help with co-pays and medicine, utility bills, home repair. The care recipient must be over 60 years of age.

<u>Supportive Services</u>: Assistance with Medicare & Medicaid papers, HEAP and commodities paperwork.

Transportation:

Transportation for medical appointments, dialysis, and grocery shopping.

Well I think we made it thru winter! Now many are going to travel and will be traveling by automobile. As a AARP Safe Driving Instructor for 13 years here is a few tips before hitting the road.

- 1. Maintaining your vehicle Walk around your vehicle and check for proper tire inflation, check your headlights, brake and tail lights, check your fluid levels and check for unusual tire wear.
- 2. Have your trusted mechanic check your vehicle for any problems.
- 3. Make sure that you keep at least 10 inches between your chest and the center of the steering wheel. This allows room for your air bag to inflate. Driver airbags have reduced death by 14 percent.
- 4. Remember here in Ohio if you are using your windshield wipers your headlights must be on!
- 5. Things to have in your car- Spare tire (good condition), jack and lug wrench, first aid kit, flares or reflective device and jumper cables.

Sherriff Radcliff and his entire staff wish you a great spring and remember to buckle up and obey all traffic rules.


