- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to Section 16 of Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended, with the Articles of Association, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 08, 1965, granting certain powers to the Summit Lake Paiute Council; and,
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is currently administers a Tribal Transportation Program grant allowing the purchase and construction of a shed for heavy equipment at the Summit Lake Paiute Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Department and its partners put out a bid solicitation for services of a concrete contractor to install a concrete pad for the floor of the equipment shed but no bids were received; and
- WHEREAS, per the Tribe's Procurement Policy the Natural Resources Department Director then approached a specific vendor and obtained a quote for the necessary services and found the price for procurement will exceed the amount for which Summit Lake Paiute Council approval is needed; and
- WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Department Director has provided this quote and recommendation to the Summit Lake Paiute Council for approval;
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Summit Lake Paiute Council hereby approves procurement of concrete services for the floor of the heavy equipment storage building from Hunewill Construction.
