PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Pastor Allegra Hoots

Greetings in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, our blessed Redeemer!

Thank you for trusting me to serve as your transitional pastor and spiritual leader and for your support. Your prayers for my wellbeing and God's guidance have been effective. Your collective wisdom, goodwill, encouragement, cooperation, and willingness to freely share your time and talents have been invaluable and mean more to me than words can express.

We embarked on this covenant relationship a little over a year ago. We weathered the first year of COVID-19, adapted to social distancing, and overcame many challenges, including grieving the unexpected transition to the immortality of much-beloved, and in some cases, longtime members.

Like the rest of the world, UPC adapted to restrictions that emerged from concerns about the spread of the deadly pandemic and our desire to comply with the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) recommendations limiting face-to-face interaction. The pandemic uprooted our traditional worship services, forcing us between what seemed like a rock and a hard place. Close the building and stop gathering until the end of the pandemic or struggle with ways to keep the ministry alive and people safe and engaged.

You opted for the latter and continued supporting the church's work and growth with your gifts, prayers, and involvement in the Sunday Livestream, Bible study, book club, daily prayer rituals, observing the liturgical calendar, and attending church business meetings. Every UPC member used his or her talents to keep the ministry meaningful, relevant, and vibrant. Church

leaders went above and beyond their call of duty to plan the congregation's future and safe return to in-person gatherings.

Finally, I want to highlight steps being taken to ensure a smooth and safe return to the full use of our campus in June.

April 20, 2020 – present - building and grounds upgraded all bathrooms by replacing sink handles, having carpets and cloth furnishings professionally sanitized or removed, and hand-sanitizing dispensers are strategically placed throughout the building. Inclement weather damage to the building exterior is being addressed.

April 26, 2021- ongoing - the worship committee started planning a hybrid ministry that will permit online members and followers to access and engage in all in-person services and meetings in real-time.

April 26 - May 31 – setting up and testing hybrid ministry models.

June 6, 2021- return to in-person worship, and for the first time this year, Sunday Fellowship will take place on the lawn.

By the grace of God, and through trial, error, and constantly showing tolerant compassion for each other, we remembered that through Christ, all things are possible. Moreover, in the words of a powerful spiritual, our survival of the turbulent last year proves "little becomes much when placed in the Master's hand." To the glory of God, we lived a valuable theme - a small congregation with limited resources ministered to a worldwide audience and began developing a ministry that crosses many artificial boundaries, including culture, space, and time.

In the words of 2 Corinthians 13:14, "May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit continue with us all."

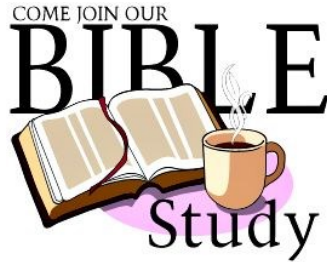

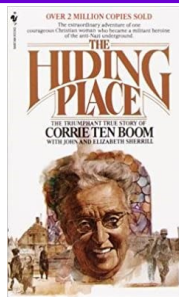

## What is Ascension Day?

May 13, 2021

The *Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord* (colloquially known as Ascension Thursday or Ascension Day) is one of the great solemnities in the Christian liturgical calendar and commemorates the bodily ascension of Jesus into heaven. Ascension Day is traditionally celebrated on a Thursday, the fortieth day of Easter (39 days after Easter Sunday). However, some Roman Catholic provinces have moved the observance to the following Sunday. The feast is one of the ecumenical feasts (i.e., universally celebrated), ranking with the feasts of the Passion, of Easter, and Pentecost.

In Western Christianity, the earliest possible date is April 30th, the latest possible date is June 3rd.

Ascension Day is a holiday in many European countries, but not in the United States, Canada, the United Kingdom and Australia. In Germany it coincides with Father's Day.

## DAY OF PENTECOST (May 23rd)

Acts 2:1-4 NIV

### The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. **2** Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. **3** They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. **4** All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.



Pentecost comes from the ancient Christian expression pentekoste hemera, which means fiftieth day (therefore applicable to the 50 days after the Resurrection of Christ).

In celebrating, some churches decorate their churches with the color red to represent the "power and fire of the Spirit". Churches often welcome new members or confirm existing members on Pentecost through baptisms and confirmations, and somewhat explains why some refer to the day as "White Sunday" in reference to the white clothing commonly worn for baptism. Additionally there are religious (church) services, Festive meals, Processions and Ordinations.

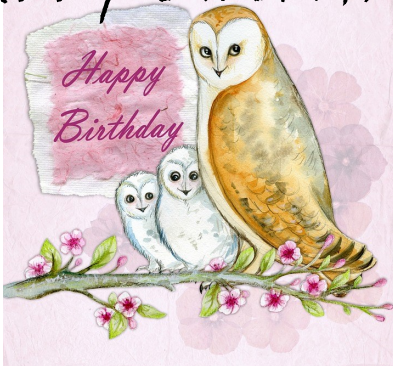

### The Day of Pentecost

**Theme:** The Holy Spirit--Pentecost

**Object:** Atomic Hot Balls

**Scripture:** Acts 2:1-4

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:1-4 (NIV)

These past few weeks have been reviewing the Holy Trinity, God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. First it was the s'more analogy—then the garden analogy—well let's keep with the theme shall we... This week we celebrate Pentecost— "It was on the day of Pentecost that God sent his Holy Spirit to the church. The Bible tells us that the apostles were all gathered together when suddenly there was a sound like a mighty, rushing wind. Then, it says, they were filled with the Holy Spirit. Tongues of fire came to rest on each of the apostles and they were filled with the Holy Spirit" (A New Wind Blowing @ Sermons4kids.com)—well...to me that must have been something like eating one of these hot balls.

It looks so innocent (well except for the atomic part and the fire part!)- here in my hand. Yummy and sweet—really, it's candy—it must be sweet RIGHT? Well, if you've ever tried one—not so much—HOT HOT HOT! So hot you wonder if you can keep it on your tongue. But, the longer you suck on it, the sweeter it gets, until finally, it's not hot anymore—just yummy sweetness.

My guess is that the Holy Spirit is the same way... It's pretty uncomfortable at first—You try really hard to share your love of Christ—I mean really—you are on fire for him!! But, when your friends look at you like you are crazy and tell you you are weird, well, you want to cast it off—It's really not much fun at all. However, you stick with it anyway—it's still hot, but just a little less so. The spirit keeps whispering in your ear every time you go against God's wishes and it still wants you to share your love of Christ with others, but it gets easier—your friends still think you are weird, but they see the changes in your life. You are making better choices. Good things are happening to you. Finally, the hot ball is only sweet—and so is the Holy Spirit. The fire still burns in you, but it is comfortable and sweet. You are confident in the ability of the Holy Spirit to guide you on the right path, even if your friends think you are weird. So, the next time you have a hot ball—I hope it reminds you that the Holy Spirit lives in you and that you should be spreading the fire to others, even when it's uncomfortable.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for sending the Holy Spirit to live in us, to whisper in our ears and our hearts when we don't follow your path for us. Help us to be on fire for you, Lord, and spread your word out into the world.
