

Get your masterpiece shown on the big screen!

Every year, Dwight Harvest Days presents movies for the community in its Outdoor Theater. To celebrate Harvest Days' 40th Anniversary, we are taking advantage of the Outdoor Theater to present short films ("shorts") created by those in the Dwight area. The top 8 short films will be selected and played on the side of the PNB bank in Downtown Dwight during Harvest Days weekend.

Eligibility

The Dwight Short Film Festival is open to all adults and high school students who reside within a 20 mile radius of Dwight or who attend a high school within a 20 mile radius of Dwight. This includes

At least one primary contributor (writer, director, cinematographer, or editor) must meet all of the above criteria for a team to enter.

Film Requirements

The film may be of just about any genre (drama, comedy, documentary, science fiction, horror, etc.), but it should be an original, scripted work. We will not consider recordings of live performances (singing, standup comedy, etc.) The film should also meet the following criteria:

- The length of the film must be between 8 and 15 minutes (at least 8 without credits and no more than 15 with credits).
- It should be an original work written by one or more members of the submitting team.
- The content should be of sufficient good taste that it would meet PG-13 standards and be suitable for public display. The judging panel maintains all rights to exclude a film from consideration that, in its judgement, does not meet this requirement or to cut out objectionable material.
- It must be produced in the year leading up to the festival, with filming ending August 1, 2018 or after.

Awards

Films will be evaluated and ranked by a panel of judges. Given that films will be submitted in a variety of genres, each judge will rank films looking at the overall value of each film, taking into consideration characteristics pertinent to each film's genre, rather than using a standardized score sheet. Individual judge rankings will be compiled to determine overall rankings.

The top 8 films, as ranked by the judging panel, will be played at the Dwight Harvest Days Short Film Festival at the Harvest Days Outdoor Theater in Downtown Dwight on Friday, September 19, 2019. The first place winner will receive a trophy, and the second through eighth place winners will receive a medal.
