

Meeting with United Emergency Medical Response (UEMR)  
March 19, 2018

Meeting began at 9:30 am. Those present reviewed comments from Attorney Brian Formella regarding proposed 10-year contract from UEMR to Ambulance Board members, then weighed the pros and cons of the proposed versus an annual or shorter-term arrangement as currently employed. Of concern was an addendum proposed by T. Grand Rapids Chair Arne Nystrom (and signed by other towns) to remove T. Grant from the Ambulance Board if the town does not sign the proposed 10-year contract as written (to which our counsel had concerns). Gary was in agreement with the stated concerns noted by counsel.

Sharon will try to meld current annual contract with UEMR with proposed 10-year contract for discussion and consideration. Jim would like to have this available at the T. Grant Annual meeting with a decision by the close of April 2018.
