Rise up, O God, O Judge of the earth. (Psalm 94:2). The earth is the Lord's and everything in it. (1 Corinthians 10:26)

All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Christ, every created thing has been put under His feet and in subjection under His authority, and He has been put far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. He comes to judge and make war and the armies of heaven and the fullness of God's Kingdom is with Him, as are His called, chosen and faithful. His victory and the victory of His people is sealed, assured and guaranteed by God, now and forever. (Matthew 28:18; Ephesians 1:21-22; Revelation 17:14; 19-11-15)

God is holy and the habitation of His throne is righteousness and justice. Mercy and truth go before His face. God will show Himself strong in and for His true people. He will always keep us and protect us from all evil and will never allow us to slip or fall or suffer our feet to be moved. He is for us and nothing can stand against us or overcome us. We shall overcome just as Jesus overcame and nothing can take us out of God's hand or separate us from His love. (Psalm 89:14; 121:2-5; 1 John 4:4; 5:4; John 16:33; Revelation 17:14; John 10:28-29 Romans 8:31, 38-39)

Send out Your Rod O God and strike the nations. Bring Your shaking, justice and judgment upon them unto repentance, correction and salvation; and if not, unto destruction and temporal and eternal judgment. (Revelation 19:15; Psalm 94:10; Haggai 2:6)

The nations have sunk down in the pit which they made; In the net which they hid, their own foot is caught. The LORD is known by the judgment He executes; The wicked are snared in the work of their own hands. [Unless they repent and come to Christ,] the wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God. For the needy shall not always be forgotten; The expectation of the poor shall not perish forever. Arise, O LORD, do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged in Your sight. Put them in fear, O LORD, that the nations may know themselves to be but men. (Psalm 9)

The evil and wicked gather themselves together against the souls of Your righteous sons and daughters [in Christ], persecute, attack and oppose us and condemn innocent blood. LORD be our defense and the rock of our refuge, our shield, buckler, strong tower and sanctuary, our defender and protector. Bring upon them their own iniquity, and cut them off in their own wickedness; yes, LORD our God, cut them off. The battle is Yours Lord – fight with and for Your people and deliver every enemy into our hands and Yours. (Psalm 94:21-23; 1 Samuel 17:47; 2 Chronicles 20:15)

Draw unto Yourself and thereby to choose and submit to Jesus as their Lord and Savior all who have hearts to choose You but have not yet. And bring to fullness, maturity and make ready all who are truly Yours, thereby making manifest Your mature sons and daughters, overcomers and the bride of the Lamb, even now. Speak to Your true people mouth to

mouth, make us men and women after Your own heart, cause us to walk with You as friends, and perfect us to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

Soften the heart of Israel to You, put a new spirit within them, and bring Jacob back to You, so that Israel is gathered to You. Save, deliver and redeem Your servant Jacob. Fill the breaches and gaps in the wall around Israel and provide for it a hedge of protection all around it from its enemies. Bring peace to Jerusalem, fully establish it, and make it a praise in the Earth. Tabernacle and dwell there in fullness in and with Your true people. (Ezekiel 11:19; Isaiah 49:5; Matthew 23:37; Isaiah 48:20; Ezekiel 13:5; Psalm 122:6; 62:6-7; Revelation 21:3)

Unite the spiritual olive tree of Israel such that Jewish and non-Jewish brother and sisters are united together as one in Christ. Lead us in unity and help us to co-labor together and pray and declare Your will as one heart, one mind and one voice united as one family, body, nation, church and Kingdom in Christ.

Cause Your judgments to come to fullness within the household of God. Send the spirit of judgment and the spirit of burning and purge, refine, wash and purify what calls itself Your church and ministry such that it is fully of Your heart, mind, will, purpose and Spirit. (1 Peter 4:17; Isaiah 4:4)

Expose and render powerless and harmless nullities all false prophets, apostles, teachers and leaders, tares and apostates, and cause Your people to not be deceived or harmed by them but instead to overcome them and their works. (Ezekiel 13:1; 2 Peter 2)

Help Your lights to arise and shine, arise over us and cause Your glory to rise and be seen upon us. (Isaiah 60:1-2) Bring Your fire to baptize, empower, consume and go before Your people such that we may burn as one with You and for You, and to burn up and destroy all that is not of You. (Matthew Acts 2; 3:11, 13:30, 40-42; Deuteronomy 9:3; Isaiah 33:14; Hebrews 12:29)

Put eternity into the hearts of your people, give us understanding of Your eternal purpose, fill us with the knowledge of Your will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding so that we walk in a manner worthy of You, pleasing to You in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of You, cause us to think, say and do only that which is in Your heart and mind, bring us into perfected oneness with You and each other. (Ecc. 3:11; Col. 1:9; 1 Sam. 2:35; John 17:21-23)

Separate what must be separated and unify and perfect what must be unified and perfected. Send Your laborers into the field, separate the wheat and the tares and bring in the final harvest. Extract unto Yourself Your remnant people from all that is not of You. (Matthew 9:38; 13:30, 37-43; John 17:21-23; Ephesians 4:13; Hebrews 6:1, 9:11; 1 John 2:5)

Help your sons and daughters fully put under our feet and crush the devil and all dark powers and make all enemies of Jesus Christ His footstool. Help us to apprehend, live, walk in and manifest the fullness of the life and victory of Christ, which is our life and victory in all fullness even now. (Hebrews 10:13; Luke 20:43; Acts 2:35)

O God pour out You Spirit upon us from on high, and make the wilderness a fruitful field, and the fruitful field as a forest. Cause justice to dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness to remain in the fruitful field. The work of righteousness will be peace, and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. Your people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places, though hail comes down on the forest, and the city is brought low in humiliation. Cause Your people to dwell safely in Goshens or similar safe areas You set apart, provide, keep, protect, cover, defend and provide for during times of shaking, judgment and other calamity upon the earth. (Isaiah 32:15-20; Exodus 8:22)

Cause all Your true sons and daughters to fully turn, submit and give ourselves to You and bring us all fully to You and into Christ. Cause us to take out the precious from the vile, to stand before You, and to be as Your mouth, one people and one voice – speaking only Your words. Make us a fortified bronze wall, so that those who fight against us shall not prevail. For You are with us to save and deliver us You have said. Please fully deliver us even now from the hand of the wicked and redeem us from the grip of the terrible. (Jeremiah 15:19-21)

Gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him, and make Your people fully free in and filled with the fullness of You. (Ephesians 1:10, 23; 3:19; 4:13; John 8:32) Cause the Lamb's bride to take her rightful place by His side and join in complete union with Him and fulfill her position in the administration of the justice, judgment, rule, reign and government of God and His Lamb.

Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come! You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. You are worthy Lamb of God to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth. Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing! Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever! (Revelation. 4:8, 11; 5:9-10, 11, 13)

Maranatha, maranatha, maranatha, come Lord Jesus, return and rule our King and Bridegroom and the Lamb of God, claim and take possession of all of what and who are Yours, and bring the fullness of Father's Kingdom and government into and upon the earth and over the second heaven, even now I pray!
