# **Hunter-Jumper Horse Show at Otter Creek Farm**

RPHSA is excited to host the final show of the 2024 season at Otter Creek Farm. Farm address is E5847 1170<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Wheeler, Wisconsin 54772.

Here are a few important things to know.

**VACCINATIONS & COGGINS:** All horses must have a negative Coggins within the past 12 months and flu/rhino vaccination within the past 6 months (but not less than 2 wks before show date). If this is your first Red Pine show of the season, you **must** bring a **copy** of both records to the show office before unloading your horse.

**RIDER WAIVERS:** All riders must sign WISCONSIN waiver upon arrival.

**ENTRIES close September 9th,** or before, if full. Late entries will be accepted if space allows.

\*IMPORTANT\* If you need a stall, you must email <a href="mailto:melissamae33@hotmail.com">melissamae33@hotmail.com</a> or text Missy 763-350-9237 to reserve. Reserving a stall at Horseshowsonline does not guarantee you a stall--you must contact Missy. Exhibitors requesting a stall must submit their entry at www.horseshowsonline.com within 1 week of reserving stall in order to keep reservation.

#### **SCHEDULE**

THURSDAY Early move-in is available for \$50 per horse. Rings are closed but trail riding is permitted. Please contact Missy Fedor to make early arrival arrangements.

FRIDAY Horses can move in starting at 9am. Schooling available in all 3 rings for \$30/horse. Schooling times are 10am-5pm.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY Hunter and jumper classes available; see schedule below.

# **SHOW RINGS & LUNGING**

Four show arenas: (1) **Main Hunter** sand outdoor ring, (2) **Upper Hunter** sand outdoor ring; (3) **Pavilion** sand outdoor ring; and (4) **Jumper** sand outdoor ring.

Lunging is permitted in sand ring behind stabling. Please do not lunge on any grass areas or in show rings. See Farm Map.

# **SCHOOLING ON DAY OF SHOW (MORNINGS)**

Schooling is available in show rings each morning from 6:30am until 30 min before classes begin. Schooling during show will be available in designated warm up areas---see Farm map.

Weather permitting, schooling opportunity for Sunday Derby classes will be announced at 12pm on Saturday in show office.

NO LUNGING IN SHOW OR SCHOOLING ARENAS. Please use designated lunging area---see Farm map.

#### **CLASSES**

HTAP- If you are showing an eligible Thoroughbred in 2'3-2'6 hunters (Class 81 or 91) or 0.85m Schooling Jumpers (Class 231), you must sign up for the companion HTAP class in order to be eligible for prize money. Horseshowsonline is Hunters=Class 500 and Jumpers=Class 501. More info can be found at <a href="http://www.rphsa.com/htap.html">http://www.rphsa.com/htap.html</a>

Stake classes- Riders must enter one, non-stake class at the same height in order to be eligible for stake class prize money.

1.0M Mini Prix is open to professionals, amateurs and juniors.

## **RED PINE FINALS**

The top 6 ranked Red Pine member riders (equitation) or horses (hunters/jumpers) in each RP division with the highest year-end point totals after Stonegate Farm's July Red Pine Show are qualified for Red Pine Finals. The 6 finalists will be scored against each other at Otter Creek in the designated over fences class (score will be taken from 2nd jumping class of that particular Red Pine division). The Red Pine member with the highest score from that class will be crowned the Red Pine Finals Champion.

\*\*This is different than Red Pine Year-end Champion because it is the highest points earners competing against each other. \*\*

## **HOW TO PARTIPCIATE:**

STEP 1: Check the Red Pine year-end results after Stonegate Farm July Red Pine Show points are added. If you or your horse are ranked in top 6 as of 8/11/24, you are qualified for Red Pine finals!

STEP 2: When registering for OCF show using <u>horseshowsonline.com</u>, be sure you enter the Red Pine finals companion class (if ranked in top 6 in your respective division). Entries open 8/17/24.

\*\*Please note the Red Pine Finals winner can and may be different than the Red Pine Year-end Champion. Red Pine Year-end Champions are based on final year-end calculations once the season concludes.

# **STABLING FEES**

Stall for Friday-Sunday \$135 if reserved by 9/9.

Stall for Friday-Sunday stall \$160 after 9/9.

(NEW IN 2024) Stalls must be cleaned when you vacate the premises. \$35 fee charged to credit card on file if stall is not cleaned.

Day stalls are very limited and cost \$80/day. Overnight is additional \$25.

Tack stalls available after stabling requests are fulfilled.

Shavings \$10/bag- 1 bag minimum.

Hay must be requested prior to arrival \$12/small square.

## **OFFICE FEES**

Method of payments include: Credit card (4% fee), cash or check. NO VENMO

When you complete your online entries at horseshowsonline.com, your credit card will hold your reservation but will not be charged until the weekend of the horse show.

Cancellation before closing date will incur \$50 fee.

After closing date, your will be charged \$30 office fee, any stabling fees and \$50 schooling fee, if applicable. The credit card on file will be charged unless other arrangements are made with show secretary.

Office fee- \$30 per horse; late entry fee is \$25 per horse.

Classes- \$30 per hunter/equitation class; \$40 per jumper class. Specialty classes vary and cost will be posted at www.horseshowsonline.com

Add-Scratch fees: SATURDAY- After 8am on day of Show \$5 per change;

Add-Scratch fees: **SUNDAY- not permitted**. All Sunday classes must be entered on Saturday by 6pm. No refunds for classes scratched on Sunday. If a rider enters Sunday class without entering, there will be \$20/fee per class plus cost of class entry fee.

RPHSA non-member fee \$8 per rider

Fee for a non-showing horse is \$60 per day if horse is not entered in 2 or more classes.

# **CAMPER/GOLF CART:**

## **CAMPING**

Camper curfew is dark (9:30pm)---all visitors under 18 yrs old must be at their camp site by this time.

- Electric/water hook-ups- weekend fee of \$140. Dry camping fee is \$60 per weekend.
- If you rent a camper from a 3<sup>rd</sup> party, you must meet the party and coordinate parking. If the show office has to assist in directing your camper to its space, you will be charged \$50 parking fee. A map of assigned camping spaces will emailed by September 19<sup>th</sup>.

## **GOLF CARTS**

Weekend rental rate is \$300. Unfortunately show management is unable to take requests for 2-seater vs 4-seater. Golf cart vendors are very difficult to secure and show mgmt. takes whatever inventory the vendor has available. If you commit to a golf cart, you will be charged even if you wanted a 4-seater and received a 2-seater.

Golf cart drivers must have valid state issued license.

Participants may bring their own golf carts. However, no electric carts are allowed unless you have a generator---they cannot be plugged into barn or camper outlets. No 4-wheelers or all-terrain vehicles (i.e., side-by-side) are allowed on the property.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY:**

#### **OFFICE FEE:**

• Once a horse has been entered online at www.horseshowsonline.com, a \$50 fee is non-refundable.

# STABLING/GOLF CARTS/CAMPING:

- Full stabling refunds will be given until entries close.
- Once entries close, no refunds will be given for any reason. (Vet or otherwise). Golf cart and camper fees will be not be refunded unless they can be sold to person on waiting list.
- Rider(s) may substitute an alternate horse.

#### **SHOW SCRATCHES:**

- Between 9/10 and 9/19, scratches will incur the cancellation fee. Reserved stabling/bedding, golf cart and camping fees will also be charged.
- From 9/20 until end of show, scratched horses will be charged the office fee and any applicable stabling/bedding, golf cart, camping fees plus a \$50 daily schooling fee. No exceptions.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

Food vendor will be available onsite Saturday and Sunday.

Be prepared for limited cell service.

Method of payments include: Credit card (4.0% fee), cash or check. NO VENMO

Barns close at 9pm each evening.

No mounted riding on property until you have signed a release in the show office and receive an entry number. Numbers must be worn when riding on the grounds at any time.

ABSOLUTELY NO JUMPING ANY CROSS-COUNTRY FENCES!!!!! Any person who jumps cross country jumps without permission will be asked to leave the farm immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS. However, trail riding for all riders is permitted and riding horses through water complex is acceptable.

## **GENERAL RULES & SPECIFICATIONS**

RPHSA follows the rules and practices as set forth by the United States Equestrian Federation. It is suggested you have access and familiarity with the USEF rulebook. In the event of a protest or discrepancy, it is recommended that the RPHSA representative(s) at the show make a ruling. This is to be first the secretary, then the show manager.

Horse welfare concerns are to be immediately disclosed to the horse show secretary. Horses entered in the show are limited to either 2 hunter divisions per day (maximum 5 h/j over fences per day). Jumper classes are limited to 4 classes per day per horse at .75m or lower and limited to 3 jumper classes per day per horse at .85m or higher.
