Once Governor DeWine opens nursing home facilities to inside public visitation, Holy Communion can be taken to those in homes, facilities, and institutions. Kindly request any minister in the Communion line, holding a pyx and requesting Hosts, to speak with the priest celebrant after Mass in order that he can remind them of this temporary protocol
