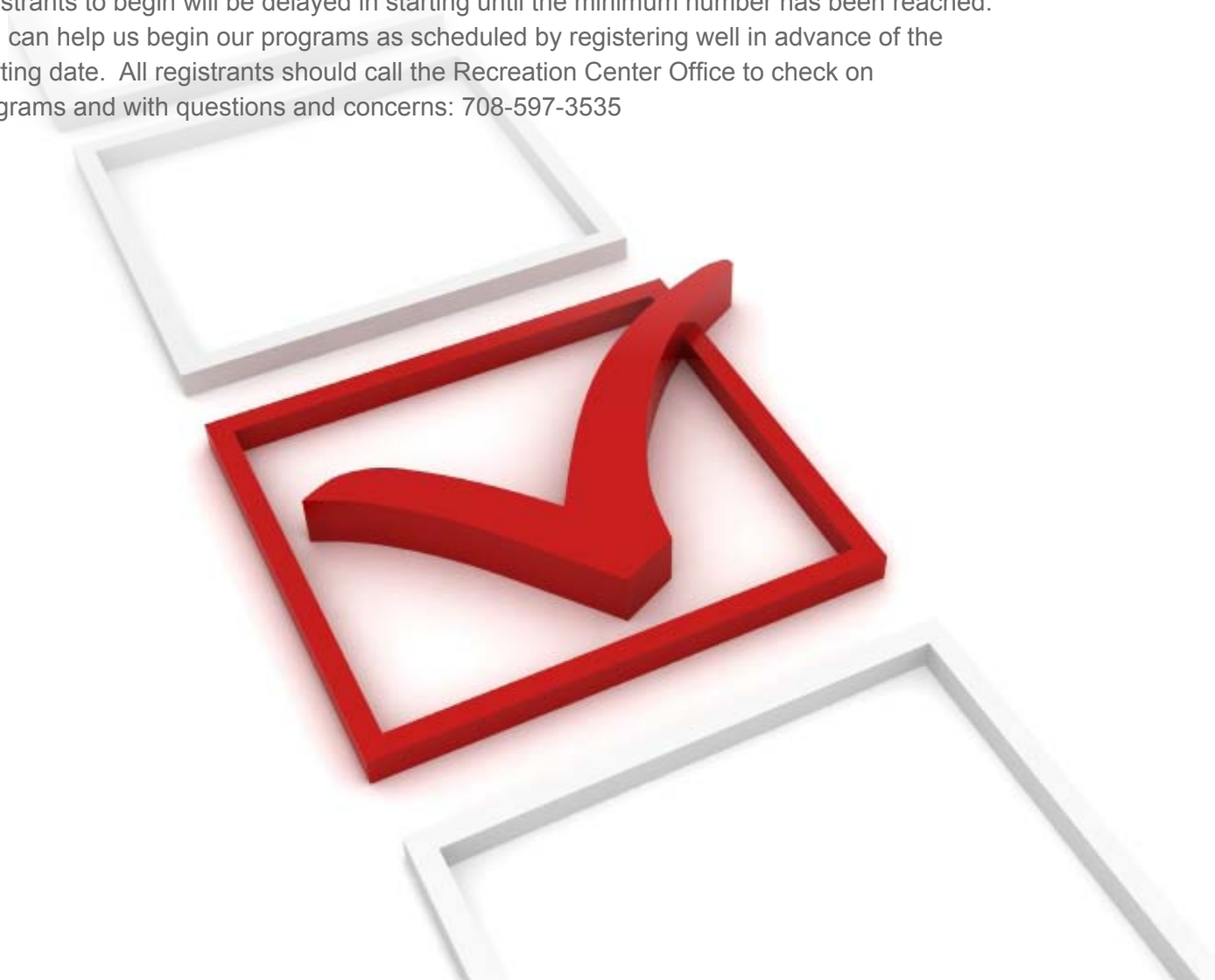


Recreation Policy

1. Programs are open to residents and non- residents. However, non-residents will pay a higher fee, unless otherwise noted.
2. Registration must be done in person, with no space reserved until fee is paid.
3. There will be absolutely no refunds given after a program has started.
4. Proof of residency will be required at the time of registration.
5. All checks must display a Calumet Park address and made payable to:
Calumet Park Recreation Department.

Note to Registrants

All Recreation Department Programs have a minimum number of participants needed in order for the program to begin. If that minimum number is achieved before the scheduled start date, the program will begin as scheduled. Programs lacking a sufficient number of registrants to begin will be delayed in starting until the minimum number has been reached. You can help us begin our programs as scheduled by registering well in advance of the starting date. SUMMER CAMP

Day Camp will begin on the second Monday of June. Registration begins the first Monday in April. We enroll ages 5 years through 12 years. There are two available time slots for the campers. Your child can attend Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Day Camp and After Care, or regular Day Camp hours from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.. The first month tuition is due no later than June 1.

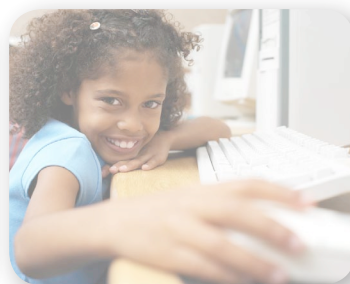

The T.L.C. PROGRAM

The T.L.C. Program will start on the first day of public school. Let the courteous Calumet Park Recreation Center Staff give your child/ children that special attention from 2:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday – Friday for children ages 5 – 12. The T. L. C. Liability Waiver

Please be aware that in registering yourself, your child or ward for participation in any Recreation Department Program, you will have to sign a “liability wavier.” The wavier releases the Recreation Department from any claims for any and all injuries you and your child/ ward may sustain while participating in any Recreation Department Programs.

Below is a sample “Liability Wavier”

“As a participant in the program described on the previous page labeled Calumet Park Recreation Center Day Camp Registration Form, or the parent/guardian of a participant in the program, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury and I agree to assume the full risk of any injuries, including death, damages or loss which I or my child/ward may sustain as a result of participating in the program against the Calumet Park Recreation Department and its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims from injuries including death, damage or loss which I or my child/ward may have of which may accrue to me or my child/ward on account of my participation in the program. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the Calumet Park Recreation Department and its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims resulting from injuries, including death, damages and losses sustained by me or my child/ward and arising out of, connecting with, or in any associated with the activities of this program.”

CALUMET PARK YOUTH BASEBALL CHILD PROTECTION REGULATION

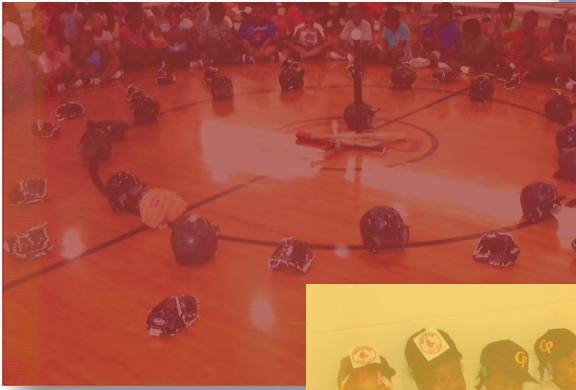
Regulation:

As a condition of service to the league, all Board Members, Managers, Coaches, or any other volunteers or hired workers who provide regular service to the league and/or have repetitive access to, or contact with players or teams, must complete and submit an official CPYB Volunteer Application to the Risk Management Director. Annual background screenings must be completed prior to the applicant assuming his/her duties for the current season. Refusal to annually submit a fully completed volunteer application must result in the immediate dismissal of the individual from the local league.

The Volunteer Application must be maintained by the Player Agent for all personnel named above for a minimum of the duration of the applicant's service to the league for that year.

Calumet Park Youth Baseball shall not permit any person to participate in any manner, whose background check reveals a conviction for any crime involving, or against a minor, crime against a person, drug related crimes, theft, gang related activity as well as any crime involving moral turpitude. CPYB may prohibit any individual from participating as a volunteer or hired worker, if the league deems the individual unfit to work with minors. Any individual who has been arrested but has not plead or been found guilty of a crime involving a minor will be suspended from the league until such charges have been dropped or the applicant has been found not guilty. Any person found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol during sanctioned CPYB activity will be suspended until such matter has been reviewed by the CPYB Board.

The Calumet Park Police Department shall conduct the background checks using applicable government operated statewide sex offender registries and criminal history databases. The police department will notify the Risk Management Director of any convictions on an applicant's background check. The Risk Management Director shall notify the Applicant by registered letter. The applicant may appeal to the Executive Board only if he or she can provide proof that a mistake involving the conviction has been made.
