#### **Traditional Scholarship Application Process**

#### Applicants receiving full athletic scholarships are not eligible to apply.

The Community of Churches for Social Action (CCSA) award scholarships to graduating **h**igh school seniors who desire to enter institutions of higher education on a full-time basis. Each eligible candidate must be a member of a local church or affiliated with the CCSA and submit a completed application onor before the deadline.

The attached application MUST be typed. Applicants will be considered for a CCSA, a San Antonio Livestock Exposition (S. A.L.E.) or Southwest Research Institute (SwRI) scholarship based upon the criteria described below.

### ONLY ONE APPLICATION IS REQUIRED.

### **CRITERIA FOR THE CCSA SCHOLARSHIP:**

- You must be a 2024 graduating high school senior.
- Accepted in an institution of higher education.
- Must attend on a full-time basis.
- All Majors are considered.

### **CRITERIA FOR THE S.A.L.E. SCHOLARSHIP:**

- United States Citizen Scholar will be required to provide proof of citizenship.
- Texas high school graduate with college enrollment within 1 year of high school.
- Must attend an accredited college or university in the state of Texas; no online degrees.
- Must maintain a GPA of 2.5 per semester.
- Must take a minimum of 12 hours per semester.
- Must pursue a S.A.L.E. approved major and courses taken must reflect a S.A.L.E.approved major, as applicable. (see attached S.A.L.E. List of Approved Majors )
- Submit a one paragraph statement explaining your selection of a major and its relevance to the S.A.L.E. mission.

**S.A.L.E. Mission:** "A Volunteer Organization that Supports Agriculture & Education to Develop the Youth of Texas"

#### **CRITERIA FOR THE SOUTHWEST RESEARCH INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP:**

- United States Citizen Scholar will be required to provide proof of citizenship.
- San Antonio high school graduate with college enrollment within 1 year of high school
- Must attend an accredited college or university, no online degrees.
- Must have a high school overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Must take a minimum of 12 hours per semester.
- Must pursue a major in any Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math (STEM) field of study and courses taken must reflect a STEM major.
- Potential to become first generation college graduate immediately following high school.
- Submit a one paragraph statement explaining your selection of a major and its relevance to Southwest Research Institute's mission.

### Supporting Documentation Required with Traditional Application

- Photograph (preferably an original, wallet-size, senior portrait head shot)
- Typed Essay: A 250 to 300 words, expounding on the statement: "HOW I CAN INCORPORATE GOD INTO MY EDUCATIONAL GOALS". Essay should be (double-spaced) on a separate sheet.
- **Typed STATEMENT OF INTENT**: On a separate sheet, type a paragraph stating your hopes, dreams, and intentions to give back to society.
- Submit current official High School Transcript through midterm of the school year (2023-2024).
- Three letters of recommendations (at least one letter from the student's senior counselor and a senior teacher in the core subjects (English, Math, Science or Social Studies) and one letter from the student's pastor.
- **Typed** Paragraph discussing how selected major is relevant to the S.A.L.E. and/or Southwest Research Institute Mission (for applicants desiring consideration for a S.A.L.E. and/or Southwest Research Institute scholarship
