

Espresso Wild Geranium

This Native perennial is both beautiful and useful. Espresso has the same characteristics as the species, the difference being the burgundy leaves. It is great for the woodland garden and naturalizing and performs well in a variety of conditions. It is known to be deer and rabbit resistant as well as drought tolerant. The seeds attract Mourning Doves and Bobwhite Quail among others. Wild Geranium is a beneficial nectar source for many Native Bees and Bumble Bees. Native Geraniums are a larval host to over 20 species of butterflies and

Geranium maculatum 'Espresso'

- Hardiness: Zone 3-8
- Size: 1-2'
- Habit: Mounded. Will self seed in ideal conditions
- Flower: Pale to deep pink/lilac, April to June
- Culture: Full sun to shade. Prefers moist, well drained soils, but tolerates poor soils
- Use: Shade garden, woodland garden, groundcover, butterflies, birds, pollinators, tolerates drought, deer and rabbits, medicinal
