Special Meeting

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Chandler at 6:05 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call: Goodin, Chandler, Wiederhold and Missler were present. Curley was absent.

Motion by Goodin to approve the agenda. Support by Missler. Motion carried.

Public Comment:

Amy Reiter questioned Chief Nick Lucas about recent training activity at a premises on Ida West and Wells Road. Someone had alerted her that Summerfield Volunteer Fire Department personnel appeared to be cooking hot dogs. Chief Lucas explained they were conducting Rapid Intervention Team Training at a vacant house. They did cook chicken, but it was paid for by the Petersburg Volunteer Firefighter's Association; not tax dollars.

Supervisor Chandler attended a River Raisin Watershed Council meeting in regards to grant writing. It was a great meeting and very informative.

Old Business:

Mercy Health rescinded their mobile van service proposal. They are willing to negotiate and have the fire department personnel obtain their physicals at St. Vincent's which is located downtown Toledo. Supervisor Chandler spoke with a manager at the Dundee, Michigan urgent care. They are open 7 days/week, 12 hours a day. They prefer to perform not more than 2-3 physicals in 1 day. Each physical takes approximately an hour and half. The following quote was provided:

- 1) Physical \$45
- 2) 10 panel instant UDS \$40
- 3) 2 view chest x-ray \$45
- 4) EKG Electro Cardio Gram \$45
- 5) Respirator Evaluation with Pulmonary Function Test \$85
- 6) Lift Test: \$25 (up to 50 lbs)
- 7) TB Skin Test \$20
- 8) Hep B titer available if needed \$50, Hep B vaccination available if needed \$75/vaccination

Motion by Goodin to rescind the motion made at the March 20th meeting contracting with Mercy Health for firefighter physicals and to contract with Dundee Urgent Care. Motion includes adding a tetanus shot to the above services if needed. Support by Wiederhold. Roll call vote: Goodin-yes, Wiederhold-yes, Missler-yes, Chandler-yes, and Curley-absent. Motion carried.

Motion by Wiederhold to adjourn the meeting at 6:33 p.m. Support by Missler. Motion carried.
