Mediterranean Stuffed Chicken, Braised Beef Short Ribs Osso Buco, and Bourbon Glazed Salmon.

We need to do our due diligence regarding the food quality if La Hacienda is selected as our caterer for the Holiday Party. Tama will call Beth to see if we could talk to past customers. The Board also approved to charge \$32.5- pp (for advance ticket sales) and \$37.50 after the cut-off date. The Board felt with offering an additional entree and a slight increase from last year this would not deter attendance for the party.
