We recognize the value of pursuing the arts, and annually offer the following scholarships to deserving high school / college students based upon the following criteria.

<u>HCMT Ruth Bliss Memorial Scholarship:</u> A student must be outstanding in the field of music or theatre arts and be furthering his/her education in one of these areas in a four-year degree program.

<u>HCMT Raymond Stoddard Memorial Scholarship:</u> A student must be pursuing his/her education in a two or four-year degree program. He/she must have demonstrated ability and interest in the creative technical areas of the theatrethrough work on high school, college and/or community theatre productions.

<u>HCMT Membership Scholarship:</u> A student may be made available to a member orson or daughter of a member of Hingham Civic Theatre who has been actively involved in HCMT for the past three (3) years and will be continuing his/her education in any field.
