

SMACNA OF WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA WILL OFFER TWO \$1000 SCHOLARSHIPS TO QUALIFIED APPLICANTS

RULES:

- 1. Graduating Seniors, who are children of an SMWIA Local 12 Member, an employee of a Contractor who contributes to the Industry Fund, or an employee of the Association shall be eligible to apply.
- 2. Applicants must rank in the upper 50% of their graduating class to be eligible to apply.
- 3. Scholarship awards are competitive and will be based on:
 - a. Academic standing of the student during high school career;
 - b. A recent college entrance examination board score;
 - c. Extracurricular, work and volunteer activities and leadership;
 - d. Character references
- 4. A scholarship winner may attend any accredited college or university of their choice in the United States, but must be enrolled in a full-time program.
- 5. The award will not be forfeited if the applicant's parents or guardian become inactive in the Industry after the award is granted.
- 6. If, for any reason, a recipient enters military service, the recipient will be eligible to receive the full amount of the award when he or she is able to attend school on a full-time basis.

- 7. The awards will be made payable to the college or university of their choice after acceptance for admission and will be mailed to that academic institution.
- 8. Applicants shall submit a complete application within the specified deadlines to receive consideration for scholarships.
- 9. In judging scholarship applications, the Scholarship Committee shall rank the candidates as 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. The 3rd place recipient shall be deemed as an alternate. If for any reason the 1st and 2nd place recipients become ineligible to accept the scholarship award, then the alternate shall move up to the place receive the next and scholarship award.
- 10. Any change in the education status of the scholarship recipient must be immediately reported to the office of SMACNA of Western Pennsylvania.
- 11. The scholarship awards being provided by SMACNA of Western Pennsylvania can only be offered and awarded as long as there is an Industry Fund.
- 12. SMACNA's Board of Directors reserves the right to revise, change or cancel the scholarship awards program at their discretion.
