OUR 90th DOURO DOINGS 2018: A VERY BIG THANKS TO ALL

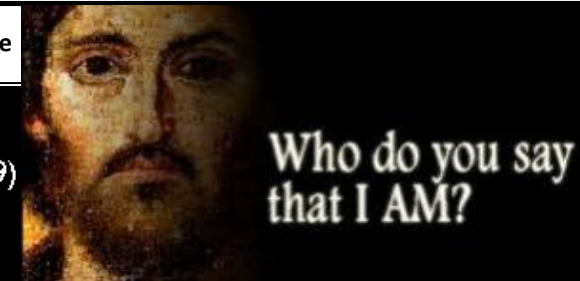
