We still need your support as our ministry continues!



Eastside has experienced shortfalls in our envelope giving in the past quarter. We appreciate all of those who give to Eastside and are thankful to all of our givers! In a small puzzle every piece is <u>so</u> important! The Gratitude Team would like to offer a heartfelt thank you to each and every "piece" of our "Eastside United Church puzzle." We appreciate the fact that we are a small congregation, and that it does take significant individual financial commitments to keep our doors open. Eastside United Church financial reports indicate that there was a deficit of \$5,387.00 at the end of December 2021.



If you haven't returned your Response form (from your Stewardship Package delivered in the fall) to let us know your commitment "piece" to the puzzle for 2022, we are still collecting them. These financial commitments help to form the basis for the annual budget. Our budget for 2022 is projecting an increase in our contributions needed to LSC by 2.68%. Meditation Schedule: Meditation has resumed online! <u>Click here</u> to join at 7 pm on Mondays.


Do you want to be a part of the LSC Messy Church Community? Follow our new Facebook page!

While open clashes ceased in 1953 with the signing of an armistice, a peace treaty has not yet been established and the war is not over. For more than 70 years the Korean people have endured a constant state of hostility and war. The Korea Peace Appeal is a global campaign that seeks to collect 100 million signatures by 2023, the 70th anniversary of the armistice.
