will be permitted in cage area while bird judging takes place)

Showmanship begins at 1:00 p.m.

MANDATORY Clean up March 18, 2023 12:00 – 1:00 p.m. (present for the entire hour)

Thank you letters for belt buckles: March 18, 2023 1:00 – 3:00 p.m.

# \*NOTE: Once an BIRD is accepted for entry on March 11, it must stay on show premises in the designated cages/area until clean-up on March 18.

#### This project is open to all Hernando County 4-H and FFA members in good standing.

Youth can show up to eight (8) birds total but must show all purebred or all crossbred. No youth can show in both divisions. Any combination of classes is permitted. There must be at least three entries in a single class to qualify for class and champion competitions.

Showmanship is optional but a youth must declare their intention at check in on March 10, 2023.

Poultry will be tested by a livestock inspector on receiving day, March 10, 2023 (or a prior date as set by FDACS and FAWE. State health and USDA requirements will supersede any other rules or health requirements. The inspector and FAWE officials can opt to treat a bird on premises and then re-examine and determine if appropriate to accept for show.

All care, feeding, cleaning, and general responsibilities for the project are the responsibility of the member who may receive assistance form FFA Advisor, 4-H leader, parent/guardian, or fellow exhibitor. Feeding of animals must be done at least once per day and must be completed by 9:00 p.m. or one hour after a show.

Clean-up is mandatory for all poultry exhibitors. They must arrive no later than 12:00 noon, check-in with appropriate FAWE personnel, and stay until 1:00 pm. Failure to attend and/or work as assigned will result in consequences that may include fines of all premiums up to \$50 and the balance if less than \$50. If fines are unpaid, exhibitors will forfeit their right to show in any species' division until paid in full.

Any livestock exhibitor earning a belt buckle must submit a thank you letter. Poultry exhibitor letters are due March 18, 2023, between 1:00 and 3:00 pm at the FAWE Livestock Office. \*Letters MUST be handwritten in pen by the exhibitor. Place letter in STAMPED, UNSEALED envelope. CLOVERBUD exhibitors may write notes in pencil! All letters must have a greeting/salutation, body paragraph (age appropriate), & a closing. Exhibitors must sign each letter. REMINDER: Exhibitors will be charged \$50 per letter not received or deemed inappropriate for any add on or belt buckle sponsor. Youth are encouraged to turn letters in early so they can be reviewed and replaced if necessary

Exhibitors agree and consent to the use of pictures, including but not limited to photographs and video of you and/or your animal in any or all publications, TV, publicity brochure, internet site, or other medium related to FAWE. Should you have privacy issues, please notify a member of the FAWE board or livestock committee in writing.

Any questions or protest concerning compliance with the rules and regulations or the eligibility of an exhibitor or their animal must be submitted in writing to the Poultry Show Chairman within 24 hours after the discovery of the infraction along with a \$100 fee. The FAWE Committee and/or Management may investigate possible infractions of rules at any time. If your protest is upheld, your fee will be returned. If your protest is unfounded, your fee is forfeited to FAWE.

Unbecoming conduct by anyone will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification!
