Hey Bully Moms & Dads...Keep those medicines & supplements up out of the reach of the fur kids!

Last year, the **Animal Poison Control Center** in Urbana received 54,000 calls concerning pets ingesting prescription drugs and supplements along with an additional 126,000 calls on other types of substances!!

**Poison Control's # is 888-426-4435.** They do charge a \$65.00 fee.

- Keep medicines up in cabinets-avoid keeping pill bottles on night stands where curious noses & paws can reach.
- Beware of the counter surfing dog who may be able to reach pill bottles on counters.
- Boxed /blister pack OTC medicines can be very attractive to chewers .
- Supplements & Pills often smell enticing to pets.
- When administering pills , pour them out away from the pets.
- Some pets find the bottles attractive to chew on.
