Ordinance O-2013-17

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING VACATION ACCRUAL FOR POLICE OFFICER RAYMOND G. MARSH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Council of Amelia Village adopted Ordinance, O-2013-16, amending the Village Personnel Policy Manual with regard to earning vacation time, and;

WHEREAS, The Council of Amelia Village appointed Raymond G. Marsh as a full-time Amelia police officer effective January 28, 2013.

WHEREAS, In compliance with the newly adopted vacation policy, it is just and equitable to make this vacation policy retroactive to his start date for Officer Marsh.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. Raymond G. Marsh shall begin earning vacation leave at the rate of forty (40) hours for his first year of full-time employment, retroactive to his date of hire as a full-time police officer, which may be taken upon reaching his employment anniversary date of one year of continuous full-time employment with Amelia Village, following normal vacation request procedures.

SECTION II. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of Amelia Village and its inhabitants. The reason for the emergency is this Ordinance will provide Officer Marsh the same vacation benefits granted to newly hired employees. Therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative of two-thirds of all members of Council it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

DERRICK CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.


