

#### **Families in Faith**

#### The Stations of the Cross:

The Stations of the Cross are a popular Catholic devotion. This devotion is also known as the "Via Crucis" or "Way of the Cross". You will normally find the Stations hanging on the walls inside a church. Sometimes a church will have an outdoor Stations of the Cross trail. These stations commemorate events from the time of Jesus's death to the placing of his body in the tomb.


