Finally some warm weather to enjoy as we hope to leave the cold behind us for the sunny days of summer. Last month the post underwent our annual inspect from the District 10 staff and thanks to Quartermaster Lehman passed with flying colors. Quartermaster Lehman continues to do a great job for the post and his efforts insures our post remains financially sound.

As you have seen, we have been focusing our funds on improving our dining area and the kitchen in the last few months. But, the winter weather did do some damage to our parking lot and we will need to spend around \$2,000 to make repairs. This will not cover all the asphalt repairs needed to our lot, but will continue our efforts to gradually improve the lot each year.

There is still a long list of repairs and improvements that need to be funded. Probably the most important one on our list is upgrading our septic tank system. We have a cost estimate of \$6,800 to make the repairs needed to this system. Additionally, our potential flooding problem from the ditch north of our parking lot is not gone, but we did do a good job of preventing any water damage, so far this year. We will probably need to spend several thousands of dollars in the near future to correct or minimize this threat. We hope to find ways to improve our patio to make it a more usable and friendly place this year. Other needed club improvements include, replacing the carpet foot runner around the main bar and laying the tile in the front men's bathroom.

The officers of the VFW board have donated hundreds of hours of their own time to make repairs and are trying to use our limited funds wisely to continue to make needed improvements. Nevertheless, unexpected breakdowns, such as the freezer in the kitchen do occur. However, thanks to our associated organizations; Auxiliary, Men's Association, VVA, Honor Guard, Y-Men, card players and others, when unforeseen problems come up we are never alone and there have been many helping hands that have reached out to us with assistance. As the Post Commander, I'm very grateful to each and every member of our post for their willingness to help solve our problems together.

Election of Post Officers: During the April board meeting all the post officers were elected by acclamation having being unopposed in their nomination for each office. Therefore, the installation of officers will take place next month. The monthly meeting is always the third Thursday of the month at 6:30 p.m.

I would like to thank the Honor Guard for having an official flag burning ceremony to retire the large quantity of old ripped and torn U.S. flags that have been collected at the post over the last few months. As you may know, burning is the official and proper way to destroy these damaged flags and the Honor Guard performs a great service to the community and our national ensign when they conduct this ceremony.

VFW Post 7201 will always be here to support the veterans of our community as long as the veterans and post members are supporting our post. Thank you all for your participation.
