August 13, 2020

In attendance: Supervisor Susan May, Deputy Supervisor Hans Boxler Jr., Councilman Andy Flint, Councilman Joe Ahl, Highway Superintendent Wade Roggow, Zoning Officer Thomas Suto, Jeff Montgomery, and Sheryl Montgomery. Quick visit by Bill Carestio.

- Called to order at 7:00 PM.
- Pledge of Allegiance
- Public Comments or Questions – none
- Approval of minutes of 7/09/20 meeting: With change made on page 3 in the first paragraph “seconded by Mr. Herma” should be “seconded by Mr. Flint” – approved by motion made by Mr. Herman, second by Mr. Flint. All in favor, none opposed.
- Information on Public Hearing for the Warsaw Fire Budget for 2021 - 2023
 - Public Hearing will take place on September 20th at 7:30 PM
- Supervisors Report:
 - Motion to approve transfer and increase to budget made by Mr. Flint, second by Mr. Herman. All in favor, none opposed.
 - Motion to approve the Supervisor’s Report by Mr. Ahl, second by Mr. Herman. All in favor, none opposed.
- Zoning Officer’s Report:
 - Town map is almost complete. Parcels are numbered and color coded for ease of finding properties.
 - Two land separations done in July, one coming up in August.
 - Ted West – Gasman Road – wants to make house into vacation home to rent out.
- Highway Superintendent’s Report:
 - Intention from CHIPS is to receive full amount. Increase was made to budget to accommodate.
 - Completed some grater patch to get ready for paving.
 - Assisted other towns with paving.
 - Royce Road and Gulf Road hill paving complete.
 - Oil and stone set for end of August for a total of 5.35 miles.
 - Obtained a 2009 air compressor to try to see if there is a desire to buy. Price would be \$1000.
 - Soil & Water completed drawings for Centerline Road hill and made suggestions for repair. Can possibly be complete for a ballpark figure of \$30,000.
 - Working with David DiMatteo for contract between Mr. Kibler and the Town of Orangeville, as part of the maintenance would be on Mr. Kibler’s land.
 - Looking for approval to possibly earmark \$30,000 from surplus if needed to get through 2020 budget. Approval granted.
 - Completed COVID improvements to bathrooms.
 - Considering waiting a year extra before replacing pickup truck. Board agreed.
 - George & Swede provided pricing on loader. Board agreed to bypass a new loader this year.

- Question from Bill Carestio - cabin built / has occupancy permit. Received bill for garbage service. Spoke with County, per Sue, needs to speak with Don Roberts. Cabin is seasonal and doesn't believe he should have to pay for garbage service as he is only out on weekends and will never use the service.
- Town Clerk's Report: Town brought in \$450 and kept \$272.94 for the month of July.
 - In addition, 2021 Budget amount for Association of Town's dues will be \$700.
- Correspondence – Youth – Swimming open at Byrnclyff from July 17, 2020 through August 28, 2020 every Friday from 4:00 – 7:00. Motion to approve by Mr. Herman, second by Mr. Flint. All in favor, none opposed.
