PLEASE READ!!!! Beginning 2/1/17 Faith Hall Rentals

In an effort to simplify and clarify the policy process for renting Faith Hall, these changes have been recommended by the Upkeep Committee and approved by Session at their January meeting. These actions were taken to ease the administration of the rental of Faith Hall, hopefully simplifying the process for Upkeep and for Kelly as our administrative scheduling agent. This effort was entered into with a sense of trying to establish greater fairness to our church and its renters.

There are two primary changes to be made. It must be clearly stated at the beginning that the "no charge rental privilege" for any active member to use the hall rent free still remains has it was in the past. It needs to be firmly stated that the "no charge" rental pertains to active members strictly for their personal activities. A member cannot reserve it free of charge for a non-member, this would apply to non-member relatives or non-member friends. They are obviously permitted, invited and even encouraged to rent on a paying basis. But they must make their own reservation and sign a contract under their name. This was decided because many rentals were being made by members believing they were helping a friend or relative. This was done with no wrong intentions but out of a sense of being helpful. These rentals left the church paying for utilities, custodial service and depreciation of the facility over time. As a side note, in conjunction with the above statement, Session has approved the

creation of a fund where the rental fees that are collected will be placed. This will allow funds to accumulate so we can invest in long range capital improvements for Faith Hall. The building is now 38 years old and much of it still has its original equipment. Hopefully this will help address these needs. Faith Hall serves us extremely well. It is used over 500 times per year, sometimes by three different groups in one day.

The second change deals with the fee for usage and applies to only non-member rentals. We are going to a flat fee charge of \$100 per rental that must be paid in full when we receive the signed contract prior to the scheduled event. The charge will be the same no matter how long a renter uses the facility on the reserved day. The prior charging method was \$30 per hour and it relied on the renter to report the exact hours of use and to pay with the return of the key after the event. This solves two potential problems, the honest reporting of hours of use and the failure to receive a final payment. It needs to be added that Kelly, working with Upkeep, did significant research with other churches and the city of Lower Burrell on their rental programs. This was done over a period of ten months to help us find the best approach to our policy and fees.

As a final statement, Faith Hall will continue to be used at no charge by non-profit charitable community groups that are considered to be part of Puckety's Mission as God's servant to the community and greater church outreach. The following is not a complete list, but here are some specific examples we support in this manner, Meals-On-Wheels, Boy and Girl Scouts, Narcotics Anonymous, Muscular Dystrophy Society and others that are approved by Session.


