#### Pre-Exam:

Students who need to retest will have two attempts to pass the exam prior to attending the live course. The two halves of the exam bar represent each attempt. The exam bar is color coded. Red indicates that the exam was failed. Green indicates that the exam was passed with a score of 90% or higher.

# Failed Exam, Next Steps:



If the student fails their first attempt, they will be able to view their Remediation Report. They will then have access to the 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt or 'make-up exam'. This 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt needs to be completed before the course and before the other tiles are accessible. If the student fails their 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt, they will need to contact their course director.
