No. 1 record, pop charts: Mack the Knife, Bobby Darrin No. 1 record, country charts: The Three Bells, The Browns Man of the Year: Dwight Eisenhower World Series winner: Los Angeles Dodgers NFL Champion: Baltimore Colts NBA Champion: Boston Celtics Miss America: Mary Ann Mobley Ben Hur was remade, the first version was a silent movie, made in 1925. The 1959 version won 11 Oscar awards. The BIC ballpoint pen was introduced to the U.S. It retailed for 19 cents. January 3rd, 1959, Alaska was admitted to the United States. August 21st, 1959, Hawaii was admitted to the United States.
