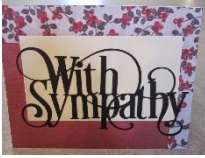

City Programs for the Youth

The City of Memphis- Office of Youth Services has two important programs for Memphis young residents:

The **MPLOY** program offers approximately 1,750 youth and young adults, ages 14-22, soft skills training, entry-level positions, and internship opportunities in various career paths while considering their strengths and interests. Some of the top employers in the Memphis area make this possible by serving as business partners while offering structured job opportunities to participants for six weeks during the summer months.

The Memphis Ambassadors Program (**MAP**) is a year-round enrichment program that engages 400-500 youth across seven city council districts in grades 9-12. MAP focuses on leadership, education, entrepreneurship, community service and perseverance. The program is designed to assist youth in developing social, critical thinking and leadership skills as they transition from high school to post-secondary options.

To be eligible for the programs, prospective applicants must be Memphis residents, ages 14-22. The application period began December 1 and ends **December 31, 2018**. For more info visit the cityofmemphisyouth.org or call 901.636.6264.
