KIDS AFTER SCHOOL LEISURE (GRADES K-G)











Our Kids After School Leisure Program is based on Canada's High Five[®] quality standard for children's recreation and sport. Our aim for this program is to provide the participants with a safe environment that promotes healthy child development, with a focus on being physically active!

Daily Activities will include:

- Zone play (imagination zone, building zone, active zone, quiet zone)
- We will spend as much time as possible outside
- Activities will focus on physical activity, fundamental movement and art

Hours of Operation: 2:30-5:30pm, Monday – Friday (no programming on regular holidays and Professional Development days scheduled at Goulds Elementary)

Ages: 5-12 (grades K-6) End Date: June 14, 2024

Space is very limited at this time. If you would like to know availability, either full-time or parttime, please email <u>gouldsrecinfo@gmail.com</u>.

Registration is only for the current school year and will not be carried over to the following school year. We strongly recommend you place your child's name on the wait list if you are unsuccessful in obtaining one of the spaces. One may become available in the current school year.

PAYMENT: Monthly payments will be required. Fees will be based on a Monday-Friday (5-day school week) of **\$100/week** for 1 child and **\$90/week** for the 2nd child in same household. There will be a prorated cost for weeks that contain Statutory holidays and PL Days. Part-time participants pay \$20/day. Payments are made by emt to gouldsrecreg@gmail.com. Monthly payments are due two weeks prior to the start of that month. If you need to discuss alternative payment plans, please feel free to give us a call at 709-745-7575 or email gouldsrecinfo@gmail.com.

TRANSPORTATION: We will be providing transportation from Goulds Elementary every school day. Transportation will not be provided from St.Kevin's Junior High.

Hours of Operation: Early drop-off is 8am, late pick up is 5:30pm. Core program activities take place between 9:30am and 4pm.

PAYMENT/CANCELLATION: Full payment is due by March 18th. March 18th is also the last day to cancel and receive a refund. A \$15 administration fee will be applied to all refunds. Refunds will not be issued past the March 18th deadline.

CHILDREN/YOUTH PROGRAMS



This is a semi Structured Active Play Program for toddlers and young children! It is all about learning the fundamental movements of early child development! It will incorporate activities around crawling, walking, running, skipping, climbing, jumping, kicking, tumbling, balancing, throwing and catching. Our counselors will lead the group through fundamental obstacle courses/activities for 40 minutes, followed by free play for 20 minutes. PARENT/GUARDIAN MUST STAY ON SITE WITH THEIR CHILD AND HELP THEIR CHILD WITH THE ACTIVITIES.

March 9 & 23



This is a Fourth R small group program to promote healthy relationships and positive mental health. The program is designed to build strengths, resilience and coping skills among youth as a way of enhancing interpersonal functioning. The whole program is designed to model appropriate use of power and respectful relationships and support youth empowerment. This will be an 8-week program.

Ages: 12 - 14 years (turning 12, 13, 14 in 2024) Where: Goulds Library <u>Cost:</u> Only \$20/participant! <u>When:</u> Mondays, 2:45-4:15pm Starting January 29th

For this program to go ahead, we require a minimum of 10 participants and a max of 14. Each session is comprised of a warm-up (ice breaker), various activities and a closing activity. It is very engaging and provides valuable lessons to youth involved. Participants who complete the course will receive a certificate.

Goulds Rec Refund Policy:

All refunds for Goulds Rec programs will be subject to a \$15 administration fee. Full refunds will only be issued if Goulds Rec cancels a program/event. Refunds will only be issued during the first 2 weeks of 8+ week programs and during the first week of 4-7 week programs. Refunds will not be issued for 2-3 week programs or for special events.

GOULDS REC: DID YOU KNOW?

- Goulds Rec is run by a Volunteer Board of Directors that consist of residents of the community who are invested in ensuring we are able to offer affordable programs and leisure activities to residents of the Goulds
- We have a lease agreement partnership with the City of St. John's. Through this positive partnership, we receive a quarterly operational grant from the City which allows us to maintain our facilities and offer a variety of programs in the Goulds, many of which are unique to our community.
- We have an Annual General Meeting every year in November, which is advertised on our outdoor sign, as well as on social media and in our Brochures. The AGM is open to anyone in the community to attend.
- Since 2005, Goulds Rec has employed an approximate total of 390 youth during the summer months, with the majority being from the community of Goulds!
- So far for the 2023 year, we have a membership of 945 participants (have participated in at least one of our programs or special events)!
 These numbers do not factor in all drop-in programs, or those attending rentals. We would love to see this number grow!
