









Furthermore, this article recognizes that the State Legislature amended Public Officers Law § 3 by adding a new Subdivision (24) expanding the residency requirements for any appointed public office in the Town of Greenburgh, Westchester County, thereby rendering Public Officers Law a special law with respect to any appointed town officer [see N.Y. Op. Atty. Gen. (Inf.) No. 91-37].

**§ 69-3. Supersession of state law.**

This article shall supersede Town Law § 23(1) in its application to the office of Deputy Town Clerk for the Town of Union Vale.

**§ 69-4. Residency requirements for Deputy Town Clerk.**

The person holding the office of Deputy Town Clerk in the Town of Union Vale need not be a resident nor an elector of the Town of Union Vale; provided, however, that such person shall reside in the county in which such town is located or an adjoining county within the State of New York.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect upon adoption by the Town Board and file date of NYS Secretary of State in accordance with the applicable provisions of law, and specifically Article 3, §27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
