Georgia Southern upset No. 20 Appalachian St 24-21 as 14-point underdogs. The Eagles were 5/1 on the money-line and it was the second year in a row, they took down a ranked App St team ending the Mountaineers unbeaten season.

Tulane is 7-2 ATS (+4.2 ppg) along with Auburn (+4.8 ppg) and Oklahoma St (-0.9 ppg). Central Michigan is 7-2-1 (+7.1 ppg). On the other side, Vanderbilt is 1-7 ATS (-5.6 ppg), Georgia Tech is 1-6-1 ATS (-3 ppg) and Rutgers is 2-7 ATS (-6.5 ppg).

SMU games are 8-1 to the OVER (+10.4 ppg) while Central Michigan games are 8-2 (+5.2 ppg). Boston College, North Texas and Memphis are all 7-2 to the OVER. On the other side, San Diego St (-9.4 ppg), South Alabama (-7.9 ppg) and California (-7.3 ppg) are all 7-1 to the UNDER.

Misleading Finals

Baylor dominated the stats vs West Virginia with 26-12 first down and 453-219 yard edges including 176-14 on the ground but only won 17-14. Baylor had 3 TO's, was stopped on 4th&Goal at the WV 1-yard line and also saw West Virginia get a 95-yard kickoff return TD.

Notre Dame had 25-12 first down and 442-240 yard edges but had several key TO's vs Virginia Tech in their 21-20 win. In the first half, ND was intercepted at the VT 9-yard line. Also in the first half was the key play of the game: ND fumbled at the VT 2-yard line which was picked up by the Hokies and returned 98 yards for a TD with :09 left in the first half (14-point swing). In the second half, ND was intercepted at the VT 2-yard line and also missed a 35-yard FG.

USC had a 31-30 first down edge and were only out-gained 405-355 in their 56-24 blowout loss to Oregon. Oregon was +3 in TO's. USC was up 10-0 early 2Q and driving, but their QB threw a pick and Oregon got a TD. On USC's next drive, they fumbled at the Oregon 3-yard line and that led to another Oregon TD. USC then threw a 32-yard "Pick 6", Oregon now led 21-10. Finally, USC got a TD with :20 left in the first half only to see Oregon return the ensuing kickoff 92 yards for a TD. 28-17 Ducks and the rout was on in the second half.

Bad Beat

We feel you if you had **OVER 48.5 in the Rutgers/Illinois** game. At 14:09 of the fourth quarter, Illinois went up 38-10. However, there were no more points the rest of the game but Illinois actually finished the game on the Rutgers 1-yard line as twice they tried to punch it in for a TD with a walk-on RB in the game.

Alabama QB Tua Tagovailoa (ankle) is questionable vs LSU this week.
 Arkansas QB John Stephen Jones has been named the starter vs Western Kentucky.
 BYU QB Zach Wilson (thumb) has been upgraded to questionable vs Liberty. Backup QB Jaren Hall (concussion) is also ?. However, 3rd string QB Baylor Romney has played well for the Cougars in each of their last 2 games (both upset wins).
 California QB Devon Modster (head) is questionable vs Washington St.
 Indiana QB Michael Penix (collarbone) is out for the season.
 Missouri QB Kelly Bryant (hamstring) is questionable vs Georgia this week.
 Notre Dame OL Robert Hainsey (ankle) is out indefinitely.
 Oklahoma St WR Tylan Wallace (ACL) is out for the season.
 Purdue QB Jack Plummer (ankle) is out indefinitely.
 USF QB Jordan McCloud (ankle) has been upgraded to probable vs Temple.

Recapping Last Week's Best Bets

Last week's **3★** on BYU was a nice easy winner as the Cougars won outright 42-14 as 3.5-point underdogs. The other **3★** on Washington looked great for almost 3 quarters with Washington leading outright throughout, but a "Pick 6" late in the 3Q changed momentum and the Huskies came up 1.5-points short of the number. Our **2★** on Virginia Tech (+17.5) nearly pulled the outright upset over Notre Dame. Meanwhile, WKU blew an early 14-0 lead as the Hilltoppers were -4 in TO's in their loss to FAU. Finally, Kansas was our worst pick on these pages getting blown out by rival Kansas St. In the NFL, our **3★** on Tampa Bay was a winner if you bet early in the week. However, if you waited until the weekend you probably lost as the Bucs fell in OT. Keep in mind, more than 3-point underdogs in the NFL are 264-16-2 ATS (94%) if the game goes to OT. The **2★** on Jacksonville in London was an abysmal failure but the other **2★** on Philadelphia was even more dominant than the final.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Wednesday, November 6th

OHIO 31 Miami, Oh 24. Ohio is on a 11-2 SU/8-3-2 ATS run in the series but did lose 30-28 (-3.5) last year. Both teams are tied on top of the MAC East standings and the winner will have an inside track at the MAC Championship game. Ohio is a little bit better in ypg differential, ppg differential and yards per play differential but Miami has played the tougher schedule. We don't see too much value here.

Thursday, November 7th

UL-Lafayette 34 COASTAL CAROLINA 23. UL-Lafayette has been one of the most impressive teams in the country this year vs expectations as they are 7-1 ATS (+9.6 ppg) and we've upgraded them 11 points in our power ratings. Coastal does come in off a win over Troy where they got a 2-point conversion late that kept their bowl hopes alive. We think you're paying a premium on ULL especially on the road on a short week laying a sizable number. Lean Coastal.

Temple 28 SOUTH FLORIDA 25. Will be interesting to see if Temple especially their defense can bounce back after back-to-back blowout losses to SMU and UCF. Meanwhile, USF has started to show some life going 3-1 SU/ATS in their last 4 games. Both teams have played similar schedules in terms of strength and statistically are close as well. However, we trust Temple here in this spot more. We also lean OVER.

Friday, November 8th

Central Florida 42 TULSA 27. Tulsa has played the much tougher schedule but the Golden Hurricane have been a bit of a tough luck team this year losing to AAC heavyweights SMU and Memphis by a combined 4 points. They face another AAC power here as UCF comes in off a non-covering win vs Houston. Note that UCF has been a bit over-valued in the market place at 1-5 ATS in their last 6. We lean with the home dog.

Washington 36 OREGON ST 26. Last week we thought we were well on our way to a 3H winner with Washington (+3.5) over Utah. The Huskies led 21-13 late in the 3Q (even with an interception at the Utah 8-yard line earlier) and had the ball. However, Washington QB Jacob Eason threw a bad "Pick 6" across the field and Utah gets momentum as they would go on a 20-0 run. "Those turnovers hurt. Hurt bad," Washington coach Chris Petersen said. On the other side, Oregon St is one of the most improved teams in the country this year. Last week they won outright at Arizona as Sunday Night Owl customers cashed. It was the Beavers' third outright upset of the season already and they nearly pulled two others vs Hawaii and Stanford. However, we're not sure we a lot of value here.

Saturday, November 9th

Clemson 45 NC STATE 12. We have two teams heading in opposite directions here. Clemson's offense is averaging 52 ppg their last 4 and QB Trevor Lawrence up to No. 8 in QBR. Meanwhile, NC State is 1-6 ATS in their last 7 games and have allowed 89 points in their last 2. The Wolf Pack can't figure out the QB position (Devin Leary 17 of 45 and 2 picks last week). Note that Clemson is 16-0 SU (+34 ppg) and 14-2 ATS (+9 ppg) vs ACC opponents. Finally, Clemson's defense is No. 1 in the nation holding opponents 165 ypg below their season average. With that being said, this is a huge number to be laying on the road. We lean OVER.

BOSTON COLLEGE 31 Florida St 28. BC comes in off their best performance of the season, a blowout win at Syracuse as 3-point underdogs. The Eagles notched a school-record 691 yards of offense. Meanwhile, FSU comes in reeling after a 27-10 loss to Miami last week. The Noles then proceeded to fire head coach Willie Taggart just 21 games into his tenure. FSU was 9-12 SU (-6.1 ppg) and 8-12-1 ATS (-6.9 ppg) under Taggart and now long-time assistant Odell Haggins takes over (was 2-0 SU/ATS as the interim in 2018). Will FSU play inspired or roll over? The answer is probably somewhere in the middle.

VIRGINIA 33 Georgia Tech 16. Virginia comes in off a big win over North Carolina that gave the Cavaliers control of the ACC Coastal Division. All they need to do is win out (home games vs GT and VT) and Virginia will play in their first ACC Championship game. Meanwhile, GT is obviously in a rebuilding year under first year coach Geoff Collins. We lean OVER as UVA's defense was dealt another blow last week with the loss of S Brenton Nelson for the season.

Texas Tech 30 WEST VIRGINIA 28. Texas Tech comes in fresh off a bye while West Virginia nearly pulled a big upset over Baylor last Thursday. Baylor dominated the stats vs West Virginia with 26-12 first down and 453-219 yard edges. Baylor had 3 TO's, was stopped on 4th&Goal at the

WV 1-yard line and also saw West Virginia get a 95-yard kickoff return TD. That has us backing off taking West Virginia here.

MIAMI, FL 29 Louisville 23. Louisville comes in fresh off a bye needing just one win in their final 4 games to get to bowl eligibility. That's remarkable considering the mess first-year head coach Scott Satterfield inherited from former coach Bobby Petrino. Meanwhile, Miami comes in off a big win over rival FSU but the Canes did lose S Bubba Bolden for the season. Our power ratings say Miami is the play here but the spot favors Louisville. We'll Pass.

2★ Duke (plus the points) Notre Dame 28 DUKE 24. In each of the last two weeks, we've cashed on these pages fading the Irish who just don't seem right since the 4Q of the USC game. We're fading them again here. Last week they nearly lost outright to Virginia Tech needing a 18-play 87-yard drive in the final minutes (including 2 4th-Down conversions) to win 21-20. Note that ND did have a huge yardage edge and a key play was a 98-yard fumble return TD for VT in the final seconds of the first half (14-point swing). Meanwhile, Duke comes in off a bye and this will be one of their biggest home games ever. Remember, ND has struggled with nothing to play for in November going 6-16 ATS the last 6 years and 3-15 ATS taking out last year when they were unbeaten and were still shooting for a playoff bid. We like the home team.

OHIO ST 53 Maryland 9. We think the playoff committee got it right putting the Buckeyes at No. 1 in the initial playoff rankings. No teams has been more consistently dominant this season. With that in mind, this is the biggest spread in a Big Ten since at least 1980! Ohio St is No. 1 in the country in ATS margin at +17.4 ppg and the Buckeyes have covered 7 straight games. The Buckeyes are off a bye with lowly Rutgers on deck. Remember, they nearly lost to Maryland last year and we think they'll be focused here to deliver another blowout win.

ARMY 49 Massachusetts 14. This is the biggest favorite role for Army over an FBS opponent in at least 40 years (the database we use KillerSports.com only goes back to 1980). That's saying something considering the Black Knights have lost 5 straight games. We probably should use the term "FBS" lightly when talking about this year's UMass team (and Akron for that matter) as we've never had a team power-rated lower than UMass right now. Do you really want to lay 35 with an option team?

CINCINNATI 47 Connecticut 10. Slight lean on the home team here. We think that close call Cincy got last week at East Carolina should have them relatively focused here vs an over-matched opponent. Meanwhile, UConn was run over again this time in a blowout loss vs Navy last Friday. The Huskies are No. 129 in yards per play differential (-1.9).

MICHIGAN ST 30 Illinois 17. Michigan St does come in fresh off a bye after 3 straight losses (by a combined 100-17) but they suffered another key loss in losing LB Joe Bachie who tested positive for PED's. Meanwhile, Illinois is feeling good about themselves after 3 straight wins and needs just one more to get to bowl eligibility. Last week they did benefit from two non-offensive TD's in their blowout win over Rutgers. However, can you really trust laying more than 2 TD's with a Michigan St offense that is averaging just 21.8 ppg?

Wake Forest 31 VIRGINIA TECH 30. Last week we cashed on these pages easily with VT in their near upset of Notre Dame as 17.5-point underdogs. On the other side, Wake saw the return of QB Jamie Newman and the Demon Deacons blasted NC State to move to 7-1 on the season. However, they haven't really played anyone yet (neither has VT outside of ND). Our power ratings are very strong on the Hokies here and we think this game comes down to the wire.

3★ SOUTH CAROLINA 30 Appalachian St 22. Sometimes we think the market gets "too smart" for their own good. Think about this one out loud...An SEC team is laying less than a TD to a Sun Belt team. That SEC team should also be motivated because they need two wins to get to bowl eligibility. Yes, the two teams have one common opponent in North Carolina and South Carolina lost to the Tar Heels while App St beat NC. However, will there be "bubble burst" for App St after seeing their unbeaten season come to an end last week? South Carolina will look to get back RB Rico Dowdle back and note QB Ryan Hilinski hasn't thrown an interception in any of his last 5 starts. Finally, South Carolina has a huge strength of schedule edge (No. 9 vs No. 124 in Sagarin's ratings)

Penn St 26 MINNESOTA 20. Both teams come in at 8-0 but Penn St has played the much tougher schedule! Minnesota has played ZERO teams in the Top 50 of our power ratings and on top of that, Minnesota has played a backup QB in 4 of their last 5 games! Meanwhile, Penn St has played 4 Top 40 teams in our power ratings! However, we think Penn St is overrated as they were out-gained by Buffalo, Pitt, Iowa and Michigan...yet won all 4 games. It's going to be a cold "old school" type of Big Ten battle here and we lean with the UNDER.

FLORIDA 37 Vanderbilt 10. Florida comes in off a disappointing loss to Georgia where they were controlled more than the final indicated (out-gained by 120 yards). Meanwhile, Vanderbilt was held to just 189 yards at South Carolina and will have to go to a 3rd string QB here in Deuce Wallace and/or Allan Walters. We don't see too much value here.

NORTHWESTERN 22 Purdue 21. The early money has come in on Northwestern here as Purdue lost QB Jack Plummer for the season and will be down to Aidan O'Connell here. The Boilers did notch a big win over Nebraska last week to keep their faint bowl hopes alive. There's no denying that the Wildcats have one of the worst offenses, if not the worst offense in college football as they average just 9.8 ppg (No. 130) and 3.65 yards per play (No. 130). To the wire.

Air Force 40 NEW MEXICO 20. This is only the 2nd time in the last 23 years, Air Force has been a 3-TD or more favorite on the road. The Falcons come in off a close win over rival Army last week. Meanwhile, New Mexico is on a 1-10-1 ATS run at home and they are dealing with an unfortunate death this week as DL Nahje Flowers passed away yesterday. They will be playing with heavy hearts and note head coach Bob Davie has had success vs Air Force going 6-1 ATS.

2★ Stanford 31 COLORADO 24. Stanford comes in fresh off a bye and prior to it got their QB KJ Costello back from injury. The only game the Cardinal have lost in their last 4 games was when they had to go to a 3rd-string QB vs UCLA. Otherwise this team looks poised to make a strong run in November. Meanwhile, the Buffaloes are heading in the wrong direction as they have allowed at least 30 points in all 9 games this year and have lost 5 straight. Make it 6.

OLD DOMINION 24 Utsa 20. Obviously, two of the worst teams in the country match-up here. UTSA comes in off a blowout loss at Texas A&M (although the Roadrunners covered). Meanwhile, Old Dominion has lost 8 straight games since the opener. They rank No. 130 in total offense (237.2 ypg) but their defense is a respectable No. 47 (allowing 360 ypg). Don't see too much value here.

ARIZONA ST 31 USC 28. After last week's blowout loss to Oregon, USC no longer controls their own destiny in the Pac-12 South and head coach Clay Helton is likely gone at the end of the season. USC actually led Oregon 10-0 but were outscored 56-14 in the final 3Q's and there is a real possibility of "quit" here. Meanwhile, Arizona St is off a bye and needs a win after back-to-back losses. ASU is slightly better in ypg differential (USC +6.0, ASU +9.1) ppg differential (USC +2.1, ASU +2.3) and ypp differential (USC +0.4, ASU +0.8).

2★ BOISE ST 31 Wyoming 13. Wyoming has lost starting QB Sean Chambers (knee) for the season. Tyler Vander Waal will take over and he does have some experience dating back to last year (9 starts in 2018) so the drop-off won't be significant. However, the Cowboys will really miss Chambers in the run game (2nd leading rusher with 567 yards and 10 TD's) and Vander Waal is only 4 of out of 16 this season in limited time. Boise did rally vs San Jose St last week as they got back QB Hank Bachmeier. He should be even better here. Our power ratings are strong on the Broncos here and it makes sense considering Wyoming is a 6-2 SU team that is -22.8 ypg this season despite facing the No. 120 schedule.

3★ BYU 40 Liberty 17. Last week we easily cashed on these pages with BYU in a 42-14 win and we go right back to them here. BYU has a huge schedule edge here as BYU has played a Top 15 schedule in terms of strength while Liberty has played a Bottom 5. This is BYU's 5th home game this year and their previous 4 all came against ranked teams (Utah, USC, Washington and Boise St). Meanwhile, Liberty hasn't played a Top 100 team since September 14th! In Liberty's last 6 games, arguably the toughest team they played was a road trip to Rutgers and Liberty lost by 10. Quite simply, BYU is the best team Liberty has played this season and their games against similar competition, the Flames lost to Syracuse by 24 and UL-Lafayette by 21. Liberty is also playing their 3rd straight road game and are traveling across the country in altitude. BYU has been solid in November the last 10 years: 23-9-3 ATS (+6 ppg). Since they moved to Independent status, BYU's schedule has been front-loaded with tough teams. Therefore, when November hits, BYU's stats and records look average, but it's because they have played tough schedules. Then the schedule gets much weaker in November (who wants to play BYU in middle of conference season)? Finally, BYU has a bunch of older players (20-23 years old instead of 18-21) that can handle the wear and tear of seasons.

Charlotte 35 UTEP 24. UTEP is 1-13 ATS in their last 14 home games. However, Charlotte has never been an away favorite before and now the 49ers are laying double-digits here. They do come in off back-to-back outright upsets over North Texas and Middle Tennessee but are in uncharted territory here. We lean OVER.

TCU 26 Baylor 25. Baylor is playing with unbeaten pressure (certainly looked like it last week vs West Virginia). Meanwhile, TCU has played the tougher schedule. The Horned Frogs are off a game where they were -3 in TO's (teams that are -3 in TO's, lose 85% of the time by an average of 17.6 ppg and fail to cover 81% of the time -11.4 ATS ppg). So the fact that TCU only lost by 7 in that spot says it wasn't that bad of a data point vs Oklahoma St. Finally, TCU is 6-1 ATS vs Baylor since joining the Big 12 with an average cover of 16 ppg. Upset!

SMU 45 East Carolina 24. How does SMU pick themselves up after the 6-point loss to Memphis last week that ended their unbeaten season and was played in a rare ABC Primetime slot? Meanwhile, ECU nearly pulled off one of the biggest upsets of the season but they came up just short vs Cincinnati last week. We don't see too much value in this one.

TEXAS ST 26 South Alabama 20. South Alabama comes in fresh off a bye. Meanwhile, Texas St is the slightly better team statistically (No. 120 vs No. 122 in ypg differential, No. 117 vs No. 122 in ppg differential and No. 110 vs No. 118 in yards per play differential). However, we're not sure this warrants laying more than 7.5-points with a total of 41.5. We lean on the dog and the OVER.

ALABAMA 35 Lsu 27. This is the first AP No. 1 vs No. 2 match-up in the regular season since 2011 (also Alabama vs LSU)! Since 1980: No. 1 is just 16-20 SU/13-21-2 ATS vs No. 2 and 1-5 SU/ATS recently. This is the smallest spread for an Alabama home game since that famed 2011 LSU/Alabama game and Alabama is 8-0 SU and 6-2 ATS vs LSU since that one with an average score of Alabama 24-9. The average total in the last 14 meetings has been 45, this year it's 65 signifying how both teams have changed recently to high-powered offenses! The main story line here is the health status of Alabama QB Tua Tagovailoa who is worth at least 7 points. This line is saying he is 50/50 in our opinion and head coach Nick Saban said it will be a game-time decision. Note that sources told ESPN that the coaching and medical staffs were pleased with the way Tagovailoa moved around in practice and the swelling in his ankle was not as severe as last season (same injury, different leg prior to the College Football play-offs). Note that this line was Alabama -16 in the summer and Alabama has won 31 straight home games by an average of 32 ppg. Each of their last 28 home wins have come by at least 14 points. While everyone will be watching this one and will want action on it, we think there is better value elsewhere on Saturday's card.

OLE MISS 44 New Mexico St 14. Last week VIP customers cashed with Ole Miss in their 6-point loss at Auburn (Rebels were catching 18). Now at 3-6, the Rebels will have to win out to get to bowl eligibility. Meanwhile, New Mexico St comes in off a bye and at 0-8, there will be no bowl for the Aggies. This one all comes down to Ole Miss' desire for margin. We lean with the UNDER.

ARKANSAS 27 Western Kentucky 24. Arkansas head coach Chad Morris has to be feeling even more heat this week after seeing Florida St make a quick move on Willie Taggart in year two. Morris hasn't been much better and this line of Arkansas -1.5 is a damning referendum of how he has done so far. Last week was a feeble effort vs an overrated Mississippi St team and QB John Stephen Jones has been named the starter here. On the other side, WKU couldn't get out of their own way last week in a loss on these pages vs Florida Atlantic as the Hilltoppers self-destructed after leading 14-0 (-4 in TO's). If Morris loses this one, he probably won't make it to year 3.

OKLAHOMA 40 Iowa St 24. Oklahoma is off a bye after the upset loss to Kansas St as a 3-TD plus favorite. The Sooners have dominated Big 12 opponents late in the season as they are on a 18-0 SU/12-5-1 ATS run in conference play in November/December. On the other side, Iowa St head coach Matt Campbell is notably 3-0 ATS vs Oklahoma with an average cover of 17.8 ppg. Campbell is also on a 20-7-2 ATS run as an underdog and the analytics crowd loves Iowa St (No. 13 in country in YPP differential). However, we expect Oklahoma to be focused here especially after coming up No. 9 in the CFB Playoff rankings.

SOUTHERN MISS 29 Uab 22. There's a lot of money coming in on UAB in the market for this one. We're not sure we agree. Southern Miss comes in fresh off a bye and while the Blazers are the better team statistically (No. 19 vs No. 41 in ypg differential, No. 38 vs No. 77 in ppg differential and No. 17 vs No. 51 in yards per play differential), the Blazers have played one of the weakest schedules of any FBS team this year. They're also a far different team away from home. Lean Southern Miss.

TROY 30 Georgia Southern 29. There's a lot of money coming in on Georgia Southern here and once again, we disagree. Yes, Troy hasn't played a tough schedule by any stretch of the imagination but they're statistically superior to Georgia Southern (No. 49 vs No. 96 in ppg differential, No. 61 vs No. 90 in ypg differential and No. 68 vs No. 87 in yards per play differential). Surely, that doesn't indicate to us that Georgia Southern is clearly the superior team like this 3-point spread is indicating. Lean on the home team as there's been an over-reaction to Georgia Southern's upset win over Appalachian St last week.

KENTUCKY 23 Tennessee 22. Tennessee is 32-2 SU (+19.1 ppg) and 25-8-1 ATS (+7.5 ppg) vs Kentucky since 1985. The Volunteers are playing their best ball of the season winning 3 of their last 4 games and they've covered 4 games in a row. However, Kentucky comes in fresh off a bye and the Wildcats arguably played their best game of the season in their last game an outright upset over Missouri as a double-digit home dog. This one will go down to the final possession.

GEORGIA 34 Missouri 17. Missouri comes in fresh off a bye. The Tigers have had a huge disparity in home/away this year. At home they are 5-0 SU (+28.8 ppg) and 4-1 ATS (+9.7 ppg). On the road they are 0-3 SU (-11.7 ppg) and 0-3 ATS (-27 ppg). Remarkably, Missouri was a double-digit favorite in those 3 road games and lost all 3! Even though Georgia only covered by a 0.5-point last week, they really impressed us. However, that's built into this steep number.

TEXAS 34 Kansas St 27. Texas should get at least 4-5 players back from injury against the Wildcats including DB Cade Sterns, DB Demarvion Overshown, RB Jordan Whittington, LB Jeffrey McCulloch and S BJ Foster. The Longhorns are off a bye after a misleading loss to TCU. QB Sam Ehlinger in that loss had his career-worst game (4 INT's). Remember, Ehlinger had only thrown 8 INT's combined in the previous 21 games! How much does Kansas St have left after two "All-Out" efforts? Obviously, we came up short fading them last week in their blowout win over Kansas. However, the market is selling them here.

LOUISIANA TECH 37 North Texas 30. Louisiana Tech is the much better team in our opinion including being No. 20 in the country in yards per play differential (+1.5). The Bulldogs are fresh coming off a bye and have won 7 straight games since an opening loss to Texas. They've covered 5 of their last 6 games. Meanwhile, North Texas saw QB Mason Fine throw for 7 TD passes last week but it came against UTEP. The Mean Green had failed to cover each of their prior 4 games and we think they'll be up against it here against the best team in the CUSA West.

Georgia St 38 UL-MONROE 36. Georgia St has been one of the biggest surprise teams in the country this year and the Panthers come in off a bye after 4 straight covers. Meanwhile, UL-Monroe is 1-5 ATS in their last 6 games and last week lost a shoot-out to Arkansas St. While there has been value on Georgia St, we don't see much here. The total has ballooned to 76.5, one of the highest totals of the year!

FLORIDA ATLANTIC 33 Florida International 24. The Shula Bowl. Lane Kiffin has gotten the best of Butch Davis in the last two meetings winning by 28 and 35 points. Last week, we faded FAU on these pages and after trailing 14-0, they took advantage of 4 WKU TO's en route to an road win. FIU is just 2-7 ATS this year and they've failed to cover 3 games in a row. We think this one will be close to the line but do lean under.

BRAD POWERS' ATS STAT OF THE WEEK:
Alabama has won 31 straight home games by an average of 32 ppg. Each of their last 28 home wins have come by at least 14 points. This week the Crimson Tide are -6.5 vs LSU.

FRESNO ST 31 Utah St 27. Last week we faded Utah St on these pages as BYU crushed the Aggies 42-14 as 3.5-point underdogs. Utah St has clearly taken a step back in the first year under Gary Andersen and we're not sure it gets better here. Meanwhile, Fresno St is off a confidence-building win at Hawai'i last week on the final play. The market has seen this line go from Fresno -3 to -6 this week. Now we don't see any value on the Bulldogs and in fact, this line now seems a bit pricey.

WISCONSIN 24 Iowa 17. Both teams come in off a bye here and the loser will essentially be out of the Big Ten West Division race. Remember, teams that are more than 7 point underdogs with a total of 43 or less are 192-148-11 (56.5%) since 2003. We question how will Wisconsin get separation here vs an Iowa defense that allows just 10.1 ppg. Also since 2013, Iowa is 22-9-2 ATS (71%) on the road. We lean with the Hawkeyes here.

Washington St 28 CALIFORNIA 21. Both teams come in off a bye. Washington St seemed to have gotten their confidence back in their last two games prior to the bye as they crushed Colorado and nearly pulled the outright upset at Oregon (we cashed on these pages on Wash St). Meanwhile, California's 4-0 start is long gone as the Bears have lost 4 straight games all without QB Chase Garbers (was hurt in the Arizona St game). Cal had to go to a 3rd string QB in the 35-0 loss at Utah and frosh QB Spencer Brasch was just 7 of 19 for 47 yards. Regular starter Chase Garbers and backup Devon Modster were both injured and both might be out again here. We're passing.

SAN DIEGO ST 30 Nevada 13. San Diego St is fresh off a bye while Nevada now needs just one more win for bowl eligibility after their 21-10 win over New Mexico last week. The Aztecs are just 3-11-1 ATS as a favorite and totals' players note the UNDER is 24-10-2 in San Diego St's last 36 games. With a total of 39, do you really want to lay 17 here? Pass.

HAWAII 40 San Jose St 31. Hawaii is just 5-17 ATS (-7.3 ppg) as a favorite and last week the Rainbow Warriors lost at home to Fresno St on the final play. That was coming off the heels of a dramatic comeback which saw Hawaii score a couple of TD's to tie in the final minute. Meanwhile, San Jose St is much improved this season. Last week the Spartans nearly upset Boise St before wearing down late in the second half. However, we're not so sure this is a good spot for them.

Week 11 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past couple of seasons we have posted computer projected lines at pregame.com. Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 224-176-10 (56%) clip the last three years. That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Last week's plays went 4-5 and now the record for this year is 57-49-2. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 5 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **TCU +2.5**.

- Ohio St is a 43.5-point favorite vs Maryland this week. That is the biggest spread in a Big Ten game since at least 1980!
- Air Force is a 21.5-point favorite at New Mexico this week. It's only the 2nd time in the last 23 years, Air Force has been a 3-TD or more favorite on the road.
- New Mexico is on a 1-10-1 ATS run at home.
- BYU is 23-9-3 ATS in November the last 10 years (+6 ppg). This week the Cougars are 17-point home favorites vs Liberty.
- UTEP is 1-13 ATS in their last 14 home games. This week UTEP is a 12.5-point underdog vs Charlotte.
- Charlotte has never been an away favorite before. This week they are laying 12.5 at UTEP.

Thursday, November 7th

OAKLAND 26 L.A. Chargers 24. After not playing a home in nearly 7 weeks, the Raiders got a win over the Lions last week. The Raiders got 4 scores from rookies, the most for them since the merger in 1970. The Raiders offensive line has allowed only 1 sack in the last 4 games and Derek Carr has a 9-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in his last 5 games. On the other side, the Chargers shockingly found a run game vs the Packers as L.A.C. ran for 159 yards (more than their previous 4 games combined) in the upset win. Maybe head coach Anthony Lynn should have got rid of Ken Whisenhunt sooner as Shane Steichen did a solid job in his debut. We lean with the Raiders.

Sunday, November 10th

Kansas City 26 TENNESSEE 23. This line is telling us Patrick Mahomes may be more probable than questionable. Last week, the Chiefs got a much-needed win at the gun vs the Vikings as Matt Moore has done a serviceable job the last couple of weeks. Meanwhile, the Titans had a 431-370 yard edge vs the Panthers but lost thanks to a -2 TO deficit. That's fitting considering the Titans just won games were they lost the stats. We're going to be on the Titans here but we'll wait until the weekend to get a bigger number. Note even if Mahomes returns, there could be some rust.

2★ Buffalo 21 CLEVELAND 20. Last week in a near must-win spot, the Browns once again failed miserably this time against a QB in Brandon Allen that had never taken an NFL snap before. Through the first 8 games of 2018, the Browns were 2-5-1 (-41 points). Through the first 8 games of 2019, the Browns are 2-6 (-53 points). The Browns are 0-3 SU/ATS at home this season and take on a Buffalo team that is 3-0 SU/ATS on the road. The Bills are off to their best start since 1993. QB Josh Allen hasn't thrown an interception in 3 straight games and Buffalo is the more reliable team here. However, note that 5 of the Bills wins (Jets, Giants, Bengals, Dolphins and Redskins) have a combined 5-36 SU record. Are the Browns that much better than those teams?

TAMPA BAY 28 Arizona 24. This is Tampa's first home game since September 22. Last week on these pages, we had Tampa as our top play. If you bet them early +6.5, you got a win. However, if you bet them late (line crashed to +4.5 in some spots), you got a loss as somehow TB gave up a TD in OT. SEA had a chance to win by 3 in regulation but missed a FG. Keep in mind, more than 3-point underdogs in the NFL are 264-16-2 ATS (94%) if the game goes to OT. Tampa did lead the game 21-7 in the 2Q. On the other side, the Cardinals gave a great effort vs the 49ers last Thursday as Arizona is now 6-3 ATS on the season. Note this is a 10am PT kickoff and Arians is facing his former team. However, we're not sure we trust the Bucs laying more than a FG here.

N.Y. GIANTS 23 N.Y. Jets 20. What is the locker room atmosphere like for the Jets? Does head coach Adam Gase even get a year two? Sam Darnold's body language wasn't great last week in the loss to the winless Dolphins. Meanwhile, the Giants are off a MNF loss to the Cowboys. Rookie QB Daniel Jones now has 8 INT's and 10 fumbles! Other than that, the Giants have been a little more respectable.

2★ Atlanta (plus the points) NEW ORLEANS 31 Atlanta 21. Both teams come in off a bye here. The Saints didn't miss a beat with the return of QB Drew Brees prior to the bye as they crushed the Cardinals (28-10 first down and 510-237 yard edges). The defense has held 5 straight opponents to under 260 yards. On the other side, Matt Ryan will return here for the Falcons (missed his first game since 2009) but at 1-7, they most likely have a lame duck coach in Dan Quinn. Give them credit though, after falling behind the Seahawks 24-0 in their last game, they didn't quit even with Matt Schaub at QB. The Saints are expensive at 6-0 SU/ATS last 6 games.

Baltimore 26 CINCINNATI 18. We really wanted to play against Baltimore after that big win over the Patriots on Sunday Night Football. Teams off the Patriots this year are 1-7 ATS. However, can you trust Ryan Finley in his first career start? Also note the Ravens just ran over the No. 1 defense in the NFL and now face the worst defense in Cincinnati (Bengals also No. 32 in rush defense).

GREEN BAY 24 Carolina 21. We just don't get some of these Packers' lines this year. Keep in mind, they were only laying 4 at home to the Lions and 5 at home to the Raiders and are now lying 5 at home to what we feel is a playoff caliber Carolina team. Last week Green Bay was run over by the Chargers which is shocking considering the Chargers had one of the worst rushing offenses in the NFL. Now that Packers defense that is allowing nearly 5.0 ypc is going up against Christian McCaffrey (160+ scrimmage yards in 6 of first 8 games). Meanwhile, The Panthers are off a win over the Titans in which they were +2 in TO's. However, they are in their preferred underdog role here at 19-10 ATS going back to the end of the 2014 season.

CHICAGO 22 Detroit 20. Last week the Bears had just 1 first down and 9 total yards in the first half in their loss to the Eagles (we cashed against them on these pages). That's now 4 straight losses for them and along with the Browns are one of the most disappointing teams of the season. Obviously, most of the blame goes on Trubisky but note the Bears rush defense is wearing down without Akiem Hicks (allowed 151 yards to the Saints, 169 to the Raiders and 146 to the Eagles). However, the Lions can't run the ball without Kerryon Johnson. The Lions come in off a close loss to the Raiders in which they were stopped at the goal line...7 of their 8 games have been decided by 7 points or less and this will as well.

INDIANAPOLIS 26 Miami 17. The Dolphins finally got their first win of the season last week and they have now covered 4 in a row. QB Fitzpatrick has completed 65% of his passes with 6 TD passes in his last 3 games. All 8 of Indianapolis' games have been decided by 7 points or less. Last week the Colts fell at the buzzer thanks to another miss from K Vinatieri (that's now 10 missed kicked this season 5 FG's and 5 XP's). With QB Jacoby Brissett banged up with a knee sprain (as of press time he is questionable), we look for the Dolphins to make it 5 straight covers. Note that Brian Hoyer if he starts for the Colts owns a 21-16-1 ATS record as an NFL starter but WR TY Hilton is doubtful here.

L.A. Rams 23 PITTSBURGH 20. The Steelers got a 96-yard "Pick Six" last week vs the Colts. That's now 19 takeaways for them (4 more than what they had the entire 2018 season). They also benefited from another missed kick by Vinatieri in their win over the Colts. Still, there seems to be a lot of positive vibe around this team and they are 55-32-4 ATS (63%) as an underdog this century! Now they face a Rams team fresh off a bye.

3★ Minnesota 24 DALLAS 23. The Vikings come in off a last-second loss to the Chiefs last week. Yes, Cousins is now 0-10-1 SU when trailing in the 4Q at Minnesota the last two years but he still has a 13-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio in his last 5 starts. Minnesota head coach Mike Zimmer is 17-3-1 ATS off a loss vs a non-division opponent. Overall, he is 40-16-3 ATS vs non-division teams. That's 71%! They're catching the Cowboys on a short-week and outside of Philadelphia who have the Cowboys beat this season? The Giants twice, the Dolphins and Redskins. Minnesota is easily better than all of them.

Monday, November 11th

SAN FRANCISCO 26 Seattle 22. The 49ers needed Jimmy G to deliver last Thursday and he played his best game of the season with 4 total TD's. They're now 8-0 for only the second time in franchise history (1990). The pick-up of Emmanuel Sanders has already paid dividends. However, now they're laying points to a Seattle team with QB Russell Wilson who has a 22-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio this season and is 22-10-3 ATS in his career as an underdog. The Seahawks are also 12-2 SU (+12.6 ppg) and 11-3 ATS (+6.3 ppg) vs the 49ers since late 2012.
