Because a portion of your dues is used for lobbying by NAHB, HBAA and HBA of Dothan and the Wiregrass Area \$32.81 is not deductible for income tax purposes (for the current year).

Of the amount remitted by me for annual dues, \$15 is for a subscription for one year to the BUILDER magazine, published monthly, and \$10 for the Nation's Building News, published bi-weekly except for July, August and December. This amount cannot be deducted from the total dues amount.
