The Participant (or parent/guardian) accepts personal financial responsibility for any injury sustained during the activity or during transportation to and from the activities. Further, the Participant (or parent/guardian) promises to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the activity sponsor or its agents, employees, volunteers, or any other representatives (collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Sponsor") for any injury related directly or indirectly out of the described activity or transportation to and from the activity, whether such injury arises out of the negligence of the Sponsor or otherwise.

If a dispute over this agreement or any claim for damages arises, the Participant (or parent/guardian) agrees to resolve the matter through a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process. If the Participant (or parent/guardian) and the Sponsor cannot agree upon such a process, the dispute will be submitted to a three-member arbitration panel of the American Arbitration Association for final resolution.

### *Covenant of Conduct*

*For Sunday School, Wednesday Nights, Retreats, Lock-ins, Events, and Camps, etc*

At all gatherings as a youth group, we will be doing our best to live together as a family in Christian community. Family life is based on unconditional love, respect, trust, support, and spending time together. Each of us as a member of the family is important. To create and maintain this relationship of family and community, all participants agree to the following covenant:

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect my youth group by being a Christ-like example for my peers and following the rules that have been given.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect my church and youth group by welcoming every individual as a member of our community, regardless of whether or not they are from Sandersville Nazarene Youth.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect the church building or rented facility. I will abide by the guidelines for conduct of any building we use and treat all property with respect.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect my youth leaders who have put time and effort into the event by fully participating in all events and assisting when asked. I will also seek to identify ways in which I can assist as a member of this community.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if I come to open gym time I am expected to stay for the service. If I leave before the service is open, I know I will not be able to participate in open gym time again until I stay for an entire service.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect other people's property by not going through or touching other's possessions.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect others' personal boundaries and right to privacy.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect what others have to say by listening when they are talking. I will allow others to speak their ideas and not distract them or take away from their ideas by talking while they are talking.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect others with my words. I will not use abusive words or profanity, be overly critical, or gossip about our youth group or others. Our youth group's definition of gossip is saying anything true or false that causes others to lower their opinion of the person being talked about.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect the guidelines set by the leaders regarding the use of cell phones and personal electronics because I know that they can distract me and others from learning more about God.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect others in the way that I dress. I understand that dressing modestly is what is expected of me. If I have any questions about what is considered appropriate, I will ask one of the group leaders.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect my youth group and myself by using only appropriate displays of affection if I am in a relationship. There must always be space between myself and the person that I am dating. Handholding and good-bye hugs are appropriate. Kissing, lying on, or too close of contact is not appropriate.

\_\_\_\_\_ I will respect the environment of the youth group by not bringing any harmful substances or items (e.g. weapons, fireworks, tobacco, illegal drugs, alcohol, or pornography).

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As a *youth* attending gatherings for Sandersville First Church of the Nazarene, I commit myself to this covenant. I also understand that there will be consequences to any inappropriate behavior. Those consequences may include being required to "sit out" from an activity or trip, staying after to talk about my behavior, my parent/guardian being called to come and pick me up if my behavior continues, and as a last resort, I could lose my privileges of coming to youth events for a time.
