He will be trying to haul in to speed up, or luff to slow down, depending on how others fall into line. We will be trying to stay in a close group to make for better pictures, maybe 4-8 boat lengths apart, but for any paraders it will be fine to be at the side of another boat (athwart ships). It will be tricky for sure to do this, but we will do our best. Meanwhile Eugene Clopton will be motoring among us in his power boat "Wolf's Gang" to get into position for the shots and/or videos of our boats. When we get close to the dam, the lead boat will turn around and head North. Whenever we are on a run, it's a great time to fly our spinnakers, if we have them, and any boat with a spinny will become the new lead boat while the others try to keep up! The whole thing should be done by about 3:30 at the latest and all pictures and videos will be available to all in the club!
