LET THE FUN BEGIN

The 2015 season begins with some games that won't necessarily eliminate any schools from contention for the post season but the way the games play out could at least let us know how much improvement some schools may have made since last year.

Texas at Notre Dame just might be the most interesting game on this first weekend as both the Longhorns and Irish look to make a statement to the rest of the country. Can Charlie Strong make huge strides in Austin or can Brian Kelly get Notre Dame squarely in the sights of the nation and start the talk of should an Independent be eligible for the playoffs (in our opinion they should). The Jim Harbaugh era begins at Michigan as the Wolverines travel to Utah to take on a very good Utes team. Can Harbaugh will this team to a successful season? Time will tell. Louisville from the ACC and Auburn from the SEC will battle at the Georgia Dome in Atlanta. The Tigers have been a very trendy team this preseason due, in part, to Will Muschamp becoming the defensive coordinator and the promise of QB Jeremy Johnson. Bobby Petrino should have a better team in 2015 than they did last year but the Cardinals are still a year or two away from really being a factor in the ACC.

Virginia makes the long trip to the west coast as they take on the UCLA Bruins. Mike London's future at UVa is contingent on his Cavaliers having their first winning season since 2011 and this sure isn't an easy way to make that happen. Jim Mora Jr enters his 4th season as the UCLA head coach. Back-to-back 10-3 seasons are nice but people will inevitably compare the Bruins to what USC is doing so the pressure is always hot in LA. A few other intriguing games this first weekend are North Carolina vs South Carolina in Charlotte, BYU at Nebraska, Arizona State vs Texas A&M in Houston, Stanford at Northwestern, Washington at Boise State, TCU at Minnesota, Penn State at Temple and Wisconsin vs Alabama from AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas.

Last but not least, on Labor Day night the defending national champion and #1 ranked, Ohio State Buckeyes try to avenge their only defeat from last year as they take on the Virginia Tech Hokies in Blacksburg. If Ezekiel Elliott can find the running lanes, that should be enough for Ohio State to come away with the victory but Frank Beamer and Bud Foster have had a long time to get prepare for the Buckeyes, so you never know.

AROUND THE NATION

The College Football Playoff selection committee has assigned conferences to its members to monitor and report on throughout Year 2 of the system. The assignment pairings are: Tom Osborne and Condoleezza Rice (American), Barry Alvarez and Pat Haden (ACC), Dan Radakovich and Steve Wieberg (Big Ten), Condoleezza Rice and Bobby Johnson (Big 12), Mike Gould and Tyrone Willingham (C-USA), Mike Tranghese and Kirby Hocutt (MAC), Tom Jernstedt and Dan Radakovich (MWC), Steve Wieberg and Kirby Hocutt (Pac-12), Tyrone Willingham and Mike Tranghese (SEC), Tom Osborne and Bobby Johnson (Sun Belt), and Tom Jernstedt and Mike Gould (Independents). Jeff Long will not monitor any conferences so he can focus on his duties as selection committee chairman.

On August 23rd, Ohio State became the first unanimous preseason #1 team in the history of the Associated Press since they began releasing a preseason poll in 1950. The Buckeyes received all 61 #1 votes in the preseason AP Poll.

As the 2015 season begins we need to take the time to appreciate some of the long tenured coaches across the country. Frank Beamer of Virginia Tech, Steve Spurrier of South Carolina, Brian Kelly of Notre Dame and Dennis Franchione of Texas State are the only coaches currently coaching at the FBS level that have 200 or more victories. Bill Snyder of Kansas State is just 13 wins short of the magical 200 win plateau. Missouris Gary Pinkel, Alabama's Nick Saban, Oklahoma's Bob Stoops, Georgia Tech Paul Johnson, Minnesota's Jerry Kill and Akron's Terry Bowden are all sitting above 150 career victories as the 2015 season begins as well.

WISCONSIN VS ALABAMA



The Wisconsin Badgers take on the Crimson Tide of Alabama at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas in a nationally televised game on ABC at 8:00 PM EDT.

This game will resemble an NFL game that you'll see on Sunday more than we are used to seeing every Saturday in college football. Both teams run a pro-style offense and very limited spread formations. Alabama features a powerful running game with Derrick Henry and Kenyan Drake running behind some very talented offensive linemen led by tackle Cam Robinson. The Tide should once again have one of the best defenses in the country. LB Reggie Ragland returns but for the most part Alabama will be fairly inexperienced but, as is usually the case, very talented.

Wisconsin lost RB Melvin Gordon to the NFL, but Corey Clement to poised to have a big year as the next man up for the Badgers at the RB position. If QB Joel Stave can improve his completion percentage, it could help open up the offense as a whole. Defensively, Wisconsin is solid but they must stay healthy because depth could be an issue.

Wisconsin leads the all-time series 1-0-0 when they beat Alabama 15-0 at Camp Randall Stadium in Madison back in 1928. Alabama is 24-13-0 vs the current 14 members of the Big Ten while Wisconsin is 9-11-0 vs the current 14 members of the SEC.

We like Alabama to win this game but Wisconsin should be able to make it respectable.

after the bowl games were played.

Which conferences had a school go undefeated in league play the most over the past 15 seasons? The now defunct Western Athletic and the Mountain West had a school go undefeated in conference play 9 times each, while a school from the MAC accomplished it had 8 times. The Big Ten 7, the SEC and the Sun Belt 6. The Big 12 Conference 5, the Big East/American Athletic Conference 5 times, the ACC 4, C-USA 3 and the Pac-12 Conference 3 times. The Big West had it happen just 1 time from 2000 until 2001 when they stopped sponsoring football.
