This is a two-day racing event. Admission pricing is altered from the standard RMX Series events. Please plan accordingly.

Gate Admission: All Riders and Spectators

- Arriving: Thursday 5:00pm thru Saturday 3:00pm
\$20.00 - 13yrs and up
\$10.00 - 6-12yrs
5yrs and under are free

Note: If you plan to race Saturday only, refunds for Sunday admission will be given until 9:00am Sunday morning. Admission wristbands must be turned in as you exit the park to receive a refund.

Fairgrounds Policies

Welcome to Rupert MX. To help us all have an enjoyable weekend and keep things running smoothly, we have a few key items we would like to share with you and a few rules we ask you to follow.

Please be aware there are other events going on at the Fairgrounds. Therefore, any activities related to motocross will be limited to the motocross track area only.

1. No unlicensed vehicles will be allowed to exit the race track area. This includes race bikes, pit bikes, ATV's, side by sides, golf carts, etc.

2. NO PIT RIDING:

- "Joy Riding" is NOT allowed anywhere on the property, including the Horse Track.
- Racers may ride their race bikes to staging in 1st gear only.
 - If you are parked in the grass motocross camping area, pit vehicles are NOT allowed. This included race bikes, pit bikes, ATV's, side by sides, golf carts etc. Spectators and mechanics are asked to walk to and from staging and all other areas.
- Pit vehicles may be used for **those parked on the Horse Track** to travel to and from the Motocross Entrance. There will be a designated parking area at the entrance for these pit vehicles.

3. In order to keep the fairgrounds clean and useable for future guests, the county has also put the following rules in place.

- No open fires of any kind are permitted.
- Please place cooled charcoal from grilles in the dumpsters.
- Please do not drain oil or fuel in the parking rea of the Horse Track.
- Please do not dig holes in the parking area of the Horse Track.
- Holes dug to level your RV should be filled in before leaving.
- Please do not wash your motorcycles or drain water from you RV onto the Horse Track. This helps to avoid soft spots due to excessive water, and keep it useable for the horses the Monday following our event.
- If you are parked on the Horse Track and need to wash your motorcycle, please contact an RMX official and we will direct you to a wash location.
