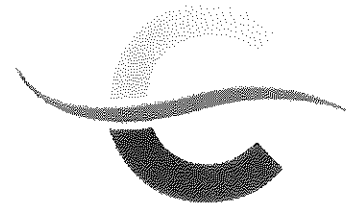

**ORDINANCE NO. 1332**

**ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 79-7  
HANDICAPPED PARKING OF CHAPTER 79 VEHICLES AND  
TRAFFIC OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF  
WILDWOOD CREST**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Wildwood Crest has determined that it is necessary and proper for good government, order and the protection of persons and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the Borough and its inhabitants to repeal, replace and supplement Section 79-7 which regulates the location of parking spaces designated for persons with disabilities in the Borough of Wildwood Crest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Wildwood Crest, in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 79-7, entitled Handicapped Parking, of Chapter 79 of the Code of the Borough of Wildwood Crest is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

**§ 79-7. Restricted parking zone for use by persons with disabilities; regulations.**

**§ 79-7.1 Restricted parking zones for use by persons with disabilities on public property, streets, shopping and business districts.**

- A. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Borough of Wildwood Crest by N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.5, the following locations are hereby designated as restricted parking for use by persons who have been issued special vehicle identification cards by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission.
- B. The locations described in Section 79-32.3 Schedule IC, attached to and made a part of this ordinance as Section 79-32.3(A) are hereby designated as restricted parking zones for use by persons with disabilities.

**§ 79-7.2. Restricted parking zones in front of residences occupied by persons with disabilities.**

- A. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Borough of Wildwood Crest by N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following locations set forth herein are designated as restricted parking zones in front of residences occupied by a person with a disability for use by such persons who have been issued by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission special vehicle identification windshield placard or wheelchair symbol license plate for a vehicle owned by the person with a disability, or by another occupant of the residence who is a member of the immediate family of the person with a disability. No other person or vehicle shall be permitted to park in these spaces.
- B. The locations described in Schedule IC, attached to and made a part of this ordinance as Section 79-32.3(B) are hereby designated as restricted parking spaces in front of residences

disability or (ii) at such time that the person with the disability no longer resides at the residence adjacent to the designated location.

- D. A designated parking place shall be permitted only if there is no off-street parking available to the person with a disability at that person's residence. For the purposes of this section, the existence of off-street driveway parking shall constitute off-street parking. All determinations as to the availability and adequacy of off-street parking shall be made by the Chief of Police, in the Chief's sole discretion.
- E. The owners of the residence referred to in this section shall be responsible for the cost of procurement of signs, installation, and pavement markings as required, which signage and markings shall be in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The owner shall also be responsible for maintenance and or replacement of such signs and pavement markings, which shall be maintained in good condition. The owner shall be responsible for the repair and restoration of the area upon removal of the designated parking space and signage.

SCHEDULE

**§ 79-32.3 Schedule IC restricted parking zones for persons with disabilities.**

- A. Only those persons authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section § 79-7.1 shall be permitted to park a vehicle upon any of the following described locations:

- B. Only those persons authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section § 79-7.2, shall be permitted to park a vehicle between the hours and days specified upon any of the following described locations.

**Section 3.** The remainder of all other sections and subsections of the aforementioned ordinance not specifically amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4.** All other ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 5.** If any portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days after final passage and advertisement thereof as required by law.
