## LIVERY STICKER REMINDER

If you utilize KYC's Livery Service, you need to have a livery sticker for your trailer. If you have a kayak or small sailboat on one of the racks, a livery sticker needs to be on your boat. Slip holders do not need stickers on their boats, but if you store your trailer up top you do need a livery sticker for your trailer.

Please pick up your sticker(s) from Kim at the bar. If you have questions, please direct them to [Joe Citriniti](#). Thank you for your cooperation.

Stickers should be on boat trailers near the tongue for sailboats, boats, and trailers on the grounds. For kayaks, canoes, lasers or other boats stored on our KYC racks - please place them on the bow of the boat.

If you are missing a sticker please add your name to the bottom of the list behind the bar and take the next sticker number in order.

Bill has served as the event's PRO for many years and has been instrumental in making each event a success. Bill was supported by the KYC Race Committee and Dave Tierson who volunteered his expert time to make for seamless adjustments on the race course. Scoring was delivered by Jenna Chervenik. Entertainment was facilitated by Craig Thayer and "The Sidekicks". A wonderful dinner and bar service was provided by Jane Russell and Kim Cunningham. Event preparations were supported by key notables including Robin Crist, Debbie Koop, Tom McConnell, Andy Hamilton, Cheryl Tierson, Roger Slade, Steve Bender, and Jenna & Chloe Chervenik. Ed Wightman and The Finger Lakes Boating Museum hosted arriving sailors with a Friday evening reception including a special viewing of the Skaneateles Lightning mold.
