



On June 10, 2020, the USATF Lake Erie Association's Board of Directors held an emergency meeting (via ZOOM). The meeting discussed this year's annual meeting and the voting of officers.

In the event we cannot have an open meeting format for the annual meeting, the meeting will be held electronically via ZOOM.

Since this year is an election year for officers, the Board proposed to have an electronic election. In order to have an electronic election, the current USATF Lake Erie Bylaw's need to be amended.

The Board decided to have an emergency electronic vote to amend the current bylaws to authorize the use of email for official communications between the USATF Lake Erie Association members and to allow use of electronic voting.

Since the Board reviewed the current bylaws, they also propose additional changes. This electronic voting will consist of twenty-five (25) individual proposed Bylaw changes.

A "yes" vote will change the current Bylaws. A "no" vote leaves them as they are.

On Monday, June 22, 2020 all valid USATF Lake Erie voting members should have received an email from Election Runner regarding the USATF Lake Erie Association's emergency voting on the ByLaws. If you did not receive an email, you can access the voting at the following link:

In order to vote you must enter a Voter ID and a Voter Key. Your Voter ID is your 10 digit USATF Membership number. Your Voter Key is your last name how it is spelled on your membership card. Your voter key is case sensitive. For example, if your name is Tony Longino-Thomas, your Voter Key would be Longino-Thomas (Use a capital L and T and use the hyphen).
