## **Requirements:**

## **Book Report Format:**

- Upcoming 5<sup>th</sup>-- 8<sup>th</sup> graders: use the attached book report form or type your report, following the required format.

These book reports will count as your first grades in Reading when you return in the fall. During the first week of school, you will be tested on your knowledge of your summer reading books, and will be required to take a test or complete a project on your books.

If you read additional books over the summer, please write them on the "Summer Reading Log" form. They will be calculated into points that you can redeem at the Scholastic Book Fair in September.

Reading is a great way to relax and have an adventure! While you are improving your reading skills, you will be taking a journey that the author is creating for you. We hope that you enjoy your summer reading. Don't leave your summer reading assignments until the end of August. Give yourself time to make this a joy and not a chore!
