

75 years ago, Japan launched its surprise attack on Pearl Harbor killing 2,433 and wounding 1,178; the United States lost 18 surface warships (sunk or seriously damaged); 188 aircraft destroyed and 159 damaged.

PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY

The next day, December 8, 1941, President Franklin Roosevelt addressed a joint session of Congress, describing the attack on Pearl Harbor as, "A Day which will live in infamy ---" The United States declared war on Japan. DATE: Wednesday 7 December 2016
