SHOW RULES

General

- Ages are as of 1st of year.
- Formal attire expected.
- All horses on Circle K-D grounds MUST have a current negative coggins or an out of state health certificate. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Safety helmets are required for riders under 18 years of age in all jumping classes. Helmets are always highly recommended in all classes at K-D.
- Boots or riding shoes with heels are required for all riders.
- Show committee has final decision on any changes or disputes.
- Classes may be cancelled or combined at chairperson(s) discretion.
- Circle K-D or its members are not responsible for any accidents, injuries or loss of property. You ride at your own risk!
- A qualified Circle K-D person will judge and manage timed events and trail class.
- No stallions allowed on grounds.
- To keep classes running in a timely manner, riders may only ride ONE horse in each speed and/or fun classes
- All Circle K-D rules will be enforced and must be followed at all times. Rules and regulations can be viewed at www.circlekd.com and will be available on the grounds the day of the show.
- This show was designed to be fun, reasonably priced and to teach or school either horse or rider for showing.
- While riding at Circle K-D, photos may be taken which will then be used on our website, Facebook or other publicity efforts to promote our club.

High Point Ribbons

- High point Ribbons awarded to riders by age group for classes 6-17 ONLY. No speed class points will apply to the high point ribbon.
- A tie in high points will be broken at the judges' discretion.
- Points awarded as follows: 1st place 10 points, 2nd place 6 points, 3rd place 4 points, 4th place 2 points, 5th place 1 point and 6th place ½ point.

Lead Line

- Judging will be based on the rider's ability to control and steer the horses themselves.
- The lead person must be at least 16 yrs of age and is there for safety in case a horse gets out of control.

Registration

- A waiver must be completed for each horse/rider combination. ALL information provided must be ACCURATE and LEGIBLE. A parent or guardian must accompany and sign for a minor.
- A card must be completed for each class that a horse/rider is participating in. ALL information provided must be ACCURATE and LEGIBLE.
- Riders will not be added to a class until the fees are paid.

Class Fees

- If you're not sure what to pay because you may be riding all day, a deposit is required in the form of an open check made out to Circle K-D. At the end of the day your classes are totaled and the check is finalized. Please note that there are no refunds for scratched classes!
- Please note that last minute changes may not be honored.
- No refunds.
