### FOOTBALL TIDBITS

Les Miles has been hired as the new head coach at Kansas. Since the start of the 2015 season, Kansas is 6-41. Les Miles has won 11 games since the start of 2015, and hasn't coached a game since Sept. 24, 2016. Miles has won at least 6 games in 14 of his 15 full seasons as head coach. Kansas hasn't had a 6-win season since 2008.

Washington State scored 55 points in the first half against Arizona, its most in a half since 1997. Gardner Minshew is the second Pac-12 player over the last 15 seasons with 5 passing TD's and 300 passing yards in a first half. WSU's Luke Falk is the other.

Illinois' 63-0 loss to lowa is tied for its worst shutout loss in program history and largest shutout loss since another 63-0 defeat to the University of Chicago in 1906.

UCLA's Joshua Kelley finished with 289 rushing yards vs Southern California, the most by a player on either team in this rivalry (88th meeting). The previous rushing mark was 260 yards by USC's Reggie Bush in 2005.

Dwayne Haskins is the first player with 400+ passing yards and 3+ rushing TD's in a game since Patrick Mahomes of Texas Tech in 2016 vs Kansas State. Haskins now has 4 of the 5 400-yard passing games in Ohio State history and they all occurred in 2018.

Pittsburgh clinched the ACC Coastal and will face Clemson in the ACC Championship Game. The Panthers will be the 6th different team in the last 6 seasons to represent the Coastal in the ACC Championship Game.

This past Saturday was the 4th time this season that Alabama's Tua Tagovailoa has thrown for 300 yards and at least 3 touchdowns. Entering this season, no player in Alabama history had more than 3 such games in his career (AJ McCarron).

Mississippi State QB Nick Fitzgerald had his 3rd season with 10+ passing TD's and 10+ rushing TD's. He joins Dak Prescott (Mississippi State) and Tim Tebow (Florida) as the only players in SEC history to do so.

Alabama had led by at least 16 points at halftime in every game this season until this past Saturday when they entered halftime tied 10-10 with The Citadel.

Maryland's Anthony McFarland is now the second player to rush for 200+ yards against Ohio State under Urban Meyer. McFarland is also the third FBS players with multiple 75 yard rushing TD's in a game this season, two of those three games came against Ohio State (Anthony McFarland & Aravis Pierce of Oregon State).

Boise State's Alexander Mattison eclipsed 1,000 rushing yards this past weekend, giving the Broncos their 10th consecutive season with a 1,000-yard rusher. That's the longest active streak in the FBS. Auburn can tie that streak, if their leading rusher, JaTarvious Whitlow, can get to 1,000 yards.

Colorado's Mike MacIntyre was fired after the Buffaloes lost their sixth straight game. MacIntyre was in his sixth season at Colorado and suffered a 30-7 setback to Utah. MacIntyre led Colorado to the Pac-12 Championship Game in 2016 and earned the AP College Football Coach of the Year honors that year. He was 30-44 overall as the Buffaloes' coach. The school will name an interim coach for the final game against California in Berkeley. If Colorado wins that game, the team would be bowl eligible. MacIntyre's contract runs through 2021 and has \$10.3 million remaining.

With the 4-6 Hokies chasing bowl eligibility, Virginia Tech has scheduled a conditional game against Marshall. If Virginia Tech defeats Virginia this Friday, the Hokies will host the Thundering Herd on December 1st in a matchup of two teams that had games canceled due to Hurricane Florence in September. If Virginia beat Virginia Tech and the Hokies fall to 4-7, the following game will be called off. The Hokies have played a bowl game in every season since the 1993 Independence Bowl.

# GAME-OF-THE-WEEK



### MICHIGAN AT OHIO STATE



The final weekend of the regular season provides us with the best regular season game of the year as Michigan (10-1) heads to the giant horseshoe in Columbus to take on Ohio State (10-1). The game will kickoff at Noon (EST) and will be televised nationally on FOX

When the season began, no quarterback was more impressive than Dwayne Haskins but as the season has worn on his numbers started to diminished (as had the overall offensive numbers for Ohio State). However, in the past few weeks, it seems that they have regained some of that explosiveness and that is a good sign for the Buckeyes.

Michigan has been a force on the defensive side of the ball all year long and now the Wolverines are putting up impressing numbers on offense. Shea Patterson has really improved as the season has progressed and that's scary for any team playing Michigan.

Michigan leads the all-time series 58-50-6. In Ohio Stadium (Opened in 1922) the Buckeyes lead 26-21-1. OSU has won 15 of the last 17 games vs Michigan (2001-2017). When both teams are ranked, the series is tied up 20-20-4. Since becoming the Buckeyes head coach, Urban Meyer has gone 6-0 vs Michigan while Jim Harbaugh is 0-3 vs Ohio State as the Wolverines head coach. This as difficult a game to predict as we've had all season long. Ohio State will score on Michigan but can the Buckeyes stop Michigan? We believe that this is the year that Jim Harbaugh gets that elusive win, 31-27
